

Praise the Lord I am now back to work in my parish of St. Peter in Nkololo, Tanzania, Diocese of Shinyanga. I arrived home Sunday evening on 08 Oct. 2023. By my calculations this was my 50th trip from the USA to Tanzania. As I get older, I thank God that airplane travel has improved greatly.

My 2nd newsletter of 2023 is being finalized at the publishers and will be sent out to the parishes that have supported our work for decades. I pray that you will take a copy home with you and perhaps share it with others. I continue to dream seemingly impossible dreams of ways to evangelize and to care for the health of the 1000's of people in our area. Songambele hospital will be well advanced when our dream of a CT Scanner becomes a reality.

We pray that a local fund raiser will be successful and help us get a Medical College under way with phase one being a nursing school. Nkololo is now a city of 20,000 or more people with 5000 students in 4 schools. We need another parish and praise the Lord we were able to get 15 acres on which to build St. Padre Pio parish. It will take years to realize our dreams but everything starts with a first step. More news to come in the future.
