

New Year's Resolutions and Into the Deep

A Reflection from Lindsay Finn, Pastorate 18's Director of Mission and Catholic Identity

At the start of this new year, two topics are on my mind that I think have at their roots in one unifying theme. The first is resolutions. I love a fresh start, a new planner, and the chance to set new goals, and January 1st is a day to celebrate or be resolute about those kind of things. The second is the in-process, Into the Deep, reality we find ourselves in throughout the Diocese of Madison. By the end of 2024, we're looking at being one new parish family. No longer being just a number (18!) but a community, united in our Catholic faith throughout Dane, Lodi, Waunakee, Westport, and the tiny towns in between.

What, you may ask, is the unifying theme that ties together New Year's resolutions and Into the Deep? In my mind, it's sanctity. By virtue of our baptism, we have been called to live as priest, prophet, and king in the midst of the world, set apart as children of God, and destined for eternal life in heaven. In order to live up to our baptismal calls, we have to take seriously the end for which we are aiming for - life forever with God in heaven. To be one with God in heaven is to be a saint. The journey of our days here on earth lead there. To forget our eternal destination or disassociate life here with life eternal is going to set us back in becoming saints.

But to become a saint can sound tiring, difficult, or, perhaps, altogether impossible. This gospel message laid before us and the expectations the Church has for us are full of challenges - to say yes to the Lord and no to ourselves and things of this world at times.

There is hope! The Church has lifted up men and woman who have run the race and are living eternally with God in heaven for us to befriend and be inspired by. The saints were like us - moms, dads, kids, students, doctors, lawyers, poor, suffering - they understand the reality of this imperfect world we're living in and the imperfection within each of us. But, they loved the Lord, they received the sacraments, they were people of prayer, and they made sanctity the defining aspect of their lives.

Let us be resolute in this new year to work on becoming saints, to say yes to the Lord in more profound ways. In doing so, let us also look to the saints for example, encouragement, and consolation in the midst of trials. Specifically, in the new year, we are going to embark on the task of looking for a name for our new parish. Take some time over this holiday season to think and pray about saints who would be great patrons and inspirations for our community - we look forward to hearing your ideas.

Lastly, a book recommendation. C.S. Lewis' *Mere Christianity* was one of the first spiritual books I made my way through when I started to take my Catholic faith seriously in college. I think his final chapter on "The New Man" is one of the most moving pieces of writing I have ever read. I'll end here with a highlight from that excellent work.

How monotonously alike all the great tyrants and conquerers have been; how gloriously different are the saints. But there must be a real giving up of the self. You must throw it away 'blindly' so to speak. Christ will indeed give you a real personality; but you must not go to Him for the sake of that. - C.S. Lewis

Dear parishioners of Pastorate 18,

Starting in the new year (January 1st , 2024), we are beginning a new process for bringing Communion to the sick and the homebound.

Instead of bringing personal pyxes forward in the Communion line or placing pyxes on the Altar before Mass begins like we currently do, we will have a more formal collection and distribution of pyxes at dedicated Masses during each month.

My hope is that in doing this we will have greater clarity about when and how someone can take Communion to a relative, friend, or fellow parishioner who is prevented from attending Mass regularly.

This process may take a little while to get used to, especially in remembering the days of the month when homebound Communion will be distributed, but I do hope that in the course of the new year it will become familiar. If you have any questions, please email me at: fr.enan@btcatholic.us.

DISTRIBUTION OF COMMUNION FOR SICK AND HOMEBOUND

Days of distribution: All Weekend Masses

& Every Thursday Daily Mass

Visit Frequency: We will be visiting the Assisted Living facilities in our Pastorate two times each month. Similarly, when visiting individuals with the Eucharist, please visit them no more than twice monthly with the Eucharist. (Please see attached note for further explanation.)

Procedure:

- 1. Bring your pyx to Mass
- 2. Take a Home Communion Card at the table near the credence table
- 3. Fill out necessary information on the card
- 4. Place the card and pyx on the tray for Home Communion near the Credence table (Altar Servers' table).

Following the regular distribution of Communion, Father will then invite those taking Communion to the Homebound to come forward and receive their pyxes. Father will distribute the pyxes with the Blessed Sacrament and then send them forth with a blessing.

After Receiving Pyx: Once you have been sent by Father, please reverently make your way to visit the homebound individuals.

Note: Out of respect for the Blessed Sacrament that you carry with you, please do not make other stops along your way until you have visited the homebound person(s).
