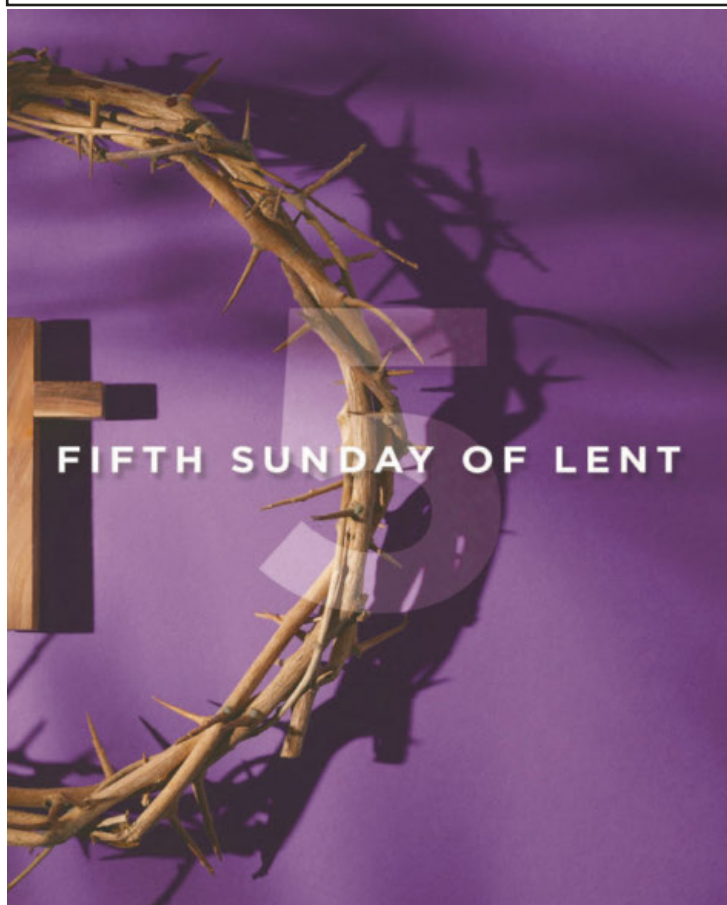





Please join us as we celebrate and prayerfully reflect on this sacred journey and mystery of our redemption.

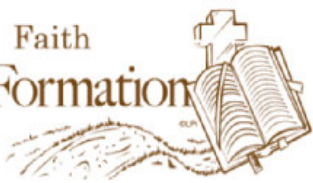
