## Don Antonio's Dispatch.....

Happy Labor Day Weekend! Though this weekend gives us the unofficial end of summer, our students at St. Pius X and Powers schools have already completed their first week of class. I hope all of you, away on vacation like me or on a "staycation" here, enjoy the long weekend. As a reminder, there is no Mass Monday morning.

As a people of faith, we look to Jesus to help us to understand labor. Jesus sanctified work by working with his foster-father, St. Joseph, as a carpenter. For most of Jesus' adult life, he was probably doing carpentry. It was only in His last three years that He began His public ministry. May God sanctify the work that we do with our hands and with our minds, and give us rest from our labors in the Kingdom of Heaven.

On Friday, 16 September we will begin Eucharistic Adoration on the third Friday of each month. Adoration will immediately follow the 8:15 am Mass, and will continue until 3 pm, at which time we will have benediction and reposition. Eucharistic Adoration, also known as Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. is a venerable tradition in the Church of extending the time of the Mass and being able to spend time with Jesus in the Eucharist.

Many parishes that are growing offer time of Adoration. Parishes that offer this tend to grow because when we spend time on our relationship with Jesus by spending time with Jesus in the Eucharist, we are transformed by our time with Jesus more and more into the saints that God wants us to be. St. John Vianney parish offers Eucharistic Adoration every first Friday, and we didn't want to duplicate what they had. There is also a Perpetual (every day) Adoration chapel in Burton. But this will be our parish's opportunity to spend time with the

We always need to have at least one person with the Blessed Sacrament at all times during Adoration. Sandy Shaker is working on having people commit to either one half hour or one hour with Jesus. If you are interested in spending time with Jesus, please contact Sandy. During your time of prayer you can pray in silence (I know I could use some silent time in my day!), pray the Stations of the Cross, pray a Rosary or a Divine Mercy Chaplet, or just talk to Jesus in your own words. I have also encouraged our teachers to bring their students to spend some time with Jesus, even if only 15 minutes. I hope that this is something which will help us to grow in our relationship with Jesus. We will definitely continue this practice through December, and for as long as people are able to commit to it. Again, contact Sandy Shaker or the parish office if you are interested in helping.




Rite of Initiation for Adults is for those desiring baptism in the Catholic Church; Formation begins on Sunday, September 18th. Call the office to register at 235-8574.

A lot has happened in the days and weeks since I last wrote a bulletin article. Most articles under my section were for job opportunities, and very little being said about our school. But, that doesn't mean *little* is happening in our school. We started a very big thing this week. We started the new school year and the kids are seeing a new priest for the first time. Sure they met Father Anthony last spring, but most kids can't remember what they did last night so for all intents and purposes this is their first time with him.

Father Anthony is doing a wonderful job with the children. He is visiting children in the classes and his first Mass with them was absolutely beautiful. I think it's easy for us as adults to view change and get ourselves all worked up over it. Change isn't easy for some adults, but it's remarkable how children adapt to change with such ease and with such an open heart. I am not trying to say that there is anything wrong with people resistant to change, but I am trying to bring light on the children and how they react to it.

Twenty-two years ago you welcomed me as a new parishioner when I came here with my then girlfriend, a parishioner her whole life. We were married here, had two children baptized here, and now I find myself beginning my ninth year as principal. I have loved every priest in our church and am excited to have Father Anthony as the leader of our school. Father Robert told me to "give him a chance", Monsignor Groshek told me to "not be resistant to change", and Jesus told me, "until you become like children..." Something tells me He knows what he's talking about.


