Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Don Antonio's Dispatch.....

Here we are in the last full week of July already!! Before we know it (and I'm sure parents are starting to get excited about this) the kids will be going back to school. Summer for me has flown by, and even though we have a few weeks of August before everything really gets going again, I will probably blink and it will be here.

This week the Church in the Diocese of Lansing celebrates two joyous events in Ann Arbor: the perpetual and first vows of a number of Dominican Sisters of Mary, Mother of the Eucharist. This congregation of Dominican sisters is flourishing, so much so that they have to turn people away who want to join their community because they don't have enough room. They wear the Dominican habit and are very faithful to the Church's teaching, and are very joyous women. I would love to have them teach in our school some day (in addition to lay teachers), but there are many steps before we can get there. Still, it's a good reminder for us to pray for vocations to religious life, especially for women. Without women religious, many of our older parishioners would not have been able to attend a Catholic school and learn the faith (even if there are a few horror stories with teaching sisters!).

Wednesday at 2 p.m. we'll have our Funeral Planning Presentation. Please RSVP by Monday so that Sharp and Swartz Funeral Homes (who are providing refreshments) can have an accurate amount of food. I'll cover the theological aspects (the funeral rites, cremation questions, etc.), and the funeral homes will share the practical aspects of funeral planning, and the benefits of pre-planning. They will also have information about their own funeral homes in case you want to work with them. They are the two funeral homes that do the most funerals here and I am happy with both of their service to our parishioners. If you have questions about how the Church does funerals or what is involved when you go to a funeral home, please come (and **remember to RSVP!**)

Last, but not least, a number of you have asked about the Witness to Hope Diocesan Capital Campaign. We are in the planning stages of the campaign, and the director for our parish has been working with me since early July. The parish-wide appeal to parishioners will be rolled out in the Fall. 
