

Don Antonio's Dispatch...

This week begins our observance of Lent with Ash Wednesday. I know I do this every year, but I'll review our Catholic Lenten observances:

Ash Wednesday

Day of Abstinence. For everyone from the 14th birthday until death. No beef, pork, or chicken. Fish and reptile meat is allowed.

Day of Fasting. For everyone from the 18th birthday until the 59th birthday (inclusive). Exceptions can be made for health reasons. One regular meal; two smaller meals which combined do not equal the regular meal. No snacking.

Fridays of Lent

Day of Abstinence. Every Friday is a day of Penance where, if we don't abstain from meat, we are supposed to do some other penitential practice. During Lent, every Friday we are required to abstain from meat. Does not apply if a Solemnity is on a Friday (19 March, 25 March).

Lenten Sacrifices

During Lent, we are encouraged to give up something and/or do something extra to unite ourselves with the suffering of Christ. Not a diet. Can add works of charity, prayer, daily Mass, etc.

We'll also be having our usual St. Pius X Lenten observances. Thursday mornings at 8:15 there will be Stations of the Cross (by St. Alphonsus Liguori). Friday evenings at 5:30 we will have soup suppers. After the soup supper (around 6:15 p.m.), I will give a reflection. This year my reflections will be on the Sacraments and how they impact our daily life. Then at 7:00 p.m. we will begin Stations of the Cross (by St. Alphonsus Liquori).

Mark your calendars, because on 12 April, after the soup supper at 5:30 p.m., with Stations of the Cross a little earlier (6:15 p.m.), the choir will be doing a Lenten Cantata at 7:00 p.m. Make sure you attend!

Last, but not least, our saint for this week is St. Casimir. He was born 3 October 1458 and died 4 March 1484. He was a prince (second oldest son) of the Kingdom of Poland and the Grand Duchy of Lithuania. He was known for his piety and generosity to the sick and the poor, and he likely died of tuberculosis. He is a witness of a public servant who, though he had great means, used them for helping others. His memorial day is 4 March and he is the patron of Poland and Lithuania. We have a church dedicated to St. Casimir in Lansing.

Our virtue last week was moderation. We emphasized the need to create healthy balances in our lives. Some of the examples included time spent on video games, iPads, and social media. We also discussed the effects of eating too many sweets as well. We will be applying lessons of moderation as we prepare our upcoming Lenten promises.

Over the last couple weeks between snow days, we finished our standardized tests. Even though we did not have ideal testing conditions, the students performed very well. One of the many benefits of a Catholic School is understanding that standardized tests are just one tool for measuring academic growth, but does not tell the whole story of a child's formation.

Last week, we sent 2 SPX students from each grade 4-8 to the GCCS spelling bee. Special congratulations to Tommy Rinoldo! Tommy will represent SPX and the GCCS at the upcoming GISD spelling bee. Along with Tommy's excitement, one of the most entertaining competitions happened among 4th graders. It was a strong field that took a while to be thinned out to a heads up match between one of our students, Timmy Dion and another from St. John Vianney. They went back and forth for so long that the moderators ran out of words and had to go find another spelling list! The moderator came back with 7th grade words. The competition still continued for some time and eventually Timmy was eliminated. In talking with Timmy afterwards, he was so proud and excited. It was clear that it was not just about winning and losing, but it was about the challenge. His perspective and attitude was developed long before he walked into the spelling bee. Like many SPX students, his family, classmates and teachers have given him the tools which have provided him the understanding that he should be proud of his successes and complimentary of others.

This month, we are doing special events to celebrate March as national reading month, and will also begin preparing for our Auction on April 27th. Please mark your calendars! There will be more on our Auction in future bulletins.
