Don Antonio's Dispatch...

Here we are in the middle of our summer time! Since March and the pandemic, time has seemed to go slowly at some times and faster at others. Summer is often a time for me to catch up on things that I have wanted to do earlier in the year, but never got around to doing. Please note that we're now on summer hours, which is normal on Monday through Thursday (8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.), but on Fridays it shortens up to 8:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

This past Wednesday also began my fifth year at St. Pius X. This is the first time I have been at one location for more than four years since I moved out of my parents' house in 2002 to go to college seminary. I had spent four years in St. Paul, Minnesota for college seminary (and staying at different parishes during the summers), four years in Detroit for major seminary (again, staying at different parishes during the summers, and an eight-month internship in Jackson, Michigan), four years in East Lansing at St. Thomas Aquinas parish (with summer studies in Chicago each summer), two years in Adrian at St. Joseph parish (with one summer of studies in Chicago). It feels really good not to move, and, more importantly, to be here!

Here's our Catechism paragraph for this week:

"Nothing is more apt to confirm our faith and hope than holding it fixed in our minds that nothing is impossible with God. Once our reason has grasped the idea of God's almighty power, it will easily and without any hesitation admit everything that [the Creed] will afterwards propose for us to believe—even if they be great and marvelous things, far above the ordinary laws of nature." Use hand sanitizer when entering and leaving the church. You may bring your own personal hand sanitizer.




People who are not from the same household, please maintain 6 feet of social distancing upon entering and exiting the church. There will be no congregating in the narthex before or after Mass.

My name is Gabriella Rex and I am a FOCUS missionary (Fellowship of Catholic University Students) at Idaho State University. 


