This week the priests of the Diocese of Lansing are meeting for the next step in the Realign Resources for the Mission (RRM) process that is looking at parish structures. Please pray for us as we meet. After the priests have met, parishioners will have a chance to review potential plans and provide input as well. I'll keep you posted as to when that is happening.

As you return to vacation mode during the summer (and an ever-increasing openness of places to visit), I encourage you to include going to Mass as part of your summer travel plans. There are churches close to most vacation spots, and it's important for your relationship with God to go to Mass each Sunday. If you are 30 minutes or more away from a church, you are not required to go, but if you travel more than 30 minutes for a one-night concert, then maybe even going more than 30 minutes to visit the Lord and be nourished by Him is not such a cross.

Here's our Catechism paragraph for the week:

God the sovereign master of his plan. But to carry it out he also makes use of his creatures' cooperation. This use is not a sign of weakness, but rather of almighty God's greatness and goodness. For God grants his creatures not only their existence, but also the dignity of acting on their own, of being causes and principles for each other, and thus of cooperating in the accomplishment of his plan. 
