## Don Antonio's Dispatch...

Rejoice! We're almost at the celebration of Jesus' Nativity!! We lighten the usual sorrowful purple for a lighter rose (not pink!!).

Another reason for rejoicing is that we will celebrate the Confirmation of one of our parishioners, Hadi, this Wednesday, 15 December at the 12:10 p.m. Mass. Congratulations, Hadi!

And yet another reason to rejoice is my parents' 42nd anniversary, which is on 14 December. Their anniversary was always the day when they (and later we kids joined in) decorated the house for Christmas, a tradition they still keep even though they're empty nesters (and have been for some time). Happy Anniversary, Mom and Dad!

As a reminder, probably the worst time to try and catch me and ask me a question or schedule something with me is right before Mass (weekday or weekend) in the sacristy. That's the time when I'm trying to prepare to enter into the holy mysteries of our faith. I am trying to recollect myself, rather than chatting with everyone. After Mass I have more time for questions, so that is a fine time to catch me about little stuff. If you need to schedule something with me, calling the office or emailing me is the best way, as I don't have my calendar with me at Mass. If it's time-sensitive (like adding a family member's name to the prayer list), that's fine. But otherwise, I ask that you please wait until after Mass to try to catch up with me. Thank you!

Here's our *Catechism* paragraph for the week:

The People of the "poor"—those who, humble and meek, rely solely on their God's mysterious plans, who await the justice, not of men but of the Messiah—are in the end the great achievement of the Holy Spirit's hidden mission during the time of the promises that prepare for Christ's coming. It is this quality of heart, purified and enlightened by the Spirit, which is expressed in the Psalms. In these poor, the Spirit is making read "a people prepared for the Lord (Luke 1:17)." 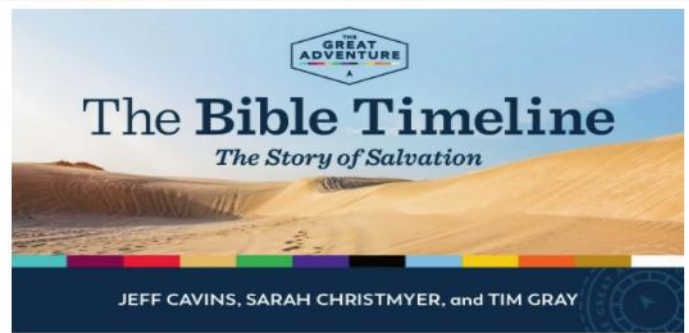

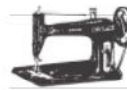
