This weekend I'm at the Equestrian Order of the Holy Sepulcher of Jerusalem Annual Investiture Weekend for the North Central Lieutenancy. Please welcome Fr. David Harvey who will be celebrating Masses Saturday through Monday, and Fr. Matthew Bonk, the new priest at St. John Vianney, will be celebrating Mass on Tuesday.

Monday, as long as my flights go as scheduled, I'll be back in time for 5:30 p.m. confessions and benediction. Tuesday I will be at the Michigan State Police Conference in Lansing, which we hold every May and October (this year it was moved a little earlier).

Thursday, in addition to being the Feast of the Archangels St. Michael, Gabriel, and Raphael, it is also the anniversary of the founding of St. Matthew parish. St. Matthew was founded on 29 September 1911, which makes the parish 111 years old. Happy Anniversary!!

Here's our *Catechism* paragraph for the week:

The principle of solidarity, also articulated in terms of "friendship" or "social charity," is a direct demand of human and Christian brotherhood (Pope St. John Paul II).

An error, "today abundantly widespread, is disregard for the law of human solidarity and charity, dictated and imposed both by our common origin and by the equality in rational nature of all men, whatever nation they belong to. This law is sealed by the sacrifice of redemption offered by Jesus Christ on the altar of the Cross to his heavenly Father, on behalf of sinful humanity (Pope Pius XII)." (n. 1939)

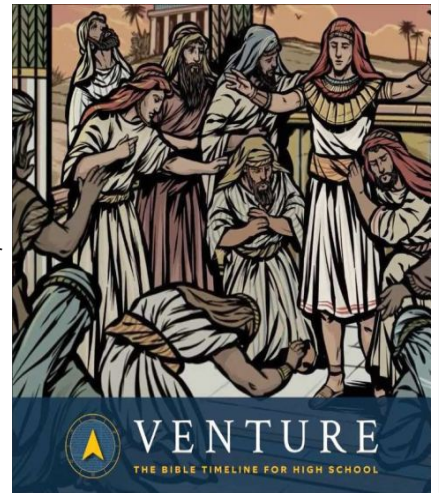

Faith Formation at St. Pius X

Does your prayer life need shaking up? Have you found that your practices leave you uninspired, bored or sleepy?

I decided to tackle Bishop Boyea's challenge and do the 30-day online retreat called *Taking Back the Crown*. It is based on the *Spiritual Exercises of St. Ignatius of Loyola*. Like me, you'll probably have to shift around some other parts of your prayer time (or daily schedule) to make room for it.

In Day 6, the presenter covers spiritual consolation and desolation. Maybe you are familiar with these? Consolation, in short, is when we experience a movement toward God, growth in our faith and an increase in love.

Desolation, is the opposite. Some characteristics of spiritual desolation might be a movement toward doubt, fear, or anger, as we experience temptations and agitations.

These are spiritual realities that can affect the interior "movements of the heart."

Interestingly, there are also *non-spiritual* realities that impact us, of which we may not be so aware.

The presenter offers this easy example:

Let's say your friend offers you a pizza. Great! What a *consolation*! Quickly you find yourself overindulging in its gooey goodness. When your overeating begins to affect how you feel, your mood, and how you treat other people, it leads you to non-spiritual desolation.

The same (only worse) can happen in *spiritual* consolation/desolation. We must examine ourselves and ask, "Is this leading me to consolation or desolation?" How we act, our response to that question, is important.

I know I'm not doing justice to this important interior work, in this brief summary, but I encourage you to examine your own life more closely against the rules of St. Ignatius of Loyola and discover God's never-ending pursuit of you through them.


