

Don Antonio's Dispatch...

Since I'm writing this before I leave for vacation, I don't have much to bring to your attention. But, as this is the bulletin after the elections, I will write a little, without knowing the results at the time of writing.

I am hoping that, miracle of miracles, Proposal 3 will be defeated. I would not say it's likely, but we trust God to do powerful things even when they seem impossible. But, no matter the results, if you voted for Proposal 3, you should not present yourself for Holy Communion until you have gone to confession for voting for such a horrible constitutional amendment. Voting for Proposal 3 is not only material cooperation with abortion, but also formal cooperation, and a grave sin against the fifth commandment. I say this not to condemn, but to call those who voted for it to repentance for the sake of their eternal souls.

Here's our *Catechism* paragraph for the week:

"Far from diminishing our concern to develop the earth, the expectancy of a new earth should spur us on, for it is here that the body of a new human family grows, foreshadowing in some way the age which is to come. That is why, although we must be careful to distinguish earthly progress clearly from the increase of the kingdom of Christ, such progress is of vital concern to the kingdom of God, insofar as it can contribute to the better ordering of human society (*Gaudium et spes*, 39 §2)." We have embraced a reductionism that acknowledges faith in Christ as essential for salvation but largely ignores the necessity of living by faith thereafter. How many of us really live each day with a confident trust in God to do what he says he will do? How many of us take him at his word and act with the expectation that he will be faithful?
