

Don Antonio's Dispatch...

Happy Pentecost! On this day we enter into the gift of the Holy Spirit to the Blessed Mother, Apostles, and disciples in the Upper Room. We, too, should pray for the continuing gift of the Holy Spirit to help us spread the Gospel.

Since Monday is Memorial Day, our offices will be closed, and all liturgical events (Mass, Adoration, Confession) are cancelled. There is a Mass at 12 noon at Old Calvary Catholic Cemetery (Ballenger, south of Flushing Road). On Memorial Day we especially remember those who served in the military who payed the ultimate price. We pray for the repose of all their souls.

Last week we also welcomed Ken Lewis, our director of maintenance, back from medical leave. Ken has been itching to get back to work and I am glad to have him back. I also want to thank Karen Downs, Tiffany LaFave, and Dan & Jackie Alling for taking care of many of Ken's responsibilities during his absence. God bless you all for your work!

St. Pius X Parishioners

I am sharing with you now the results of the survey that I asked those who attended the Town Hall to fill out. I also received a few other letters/notes of how to proceed, but this is the easiest way to report to you the sense of the parish after our 10 months of looking at our finances and demographics, and 9 days of prayer to the Holy Spirt right before our Town Hall:

Stay open until we don't have sufficient financial resources: 70.2%

Set a date to close: 26.7%

Request to become an oratory of another parish: 3.1%

As you can see, the overall and far-away choice of the parishioners is to stay open until we lack the financial resources to remain open. As I promised, this is how I will shepherd you.

I also want to share with you that, after contacting priests both here in Genesee County and in DeWitt (including priests who do not have a parish assignment and our senior/"retired" priests), there is no regular coverage for the 9 a.m. Sunday Mass at St. Pius X available after 16 July. So, our last 9 a.m. Sunday Mass at St. Pius X will be Sunday, 16 July. Fr. Tony Smela will be the celebrant (as I will be at Our Lady of Guadalupe).

This, of course, will affect how long we can continue as a parish. For budgeting purposes, the Finance Council and I expect to lose 55% of our Sunday income once we lose the 9 a.m. Mass. If that number is accurate, then we would be down to around \$100,000 (a balance which can pay about 3 months of expenses) by mid-November 2023. Once we get down to that amount, the Parish and Finance Councils and I will have a discussion about if we can even make it for three months, or if we will need to ask the bishop to suppress us as a parish. If, however, parishioners continue to give at their regular rate after the loss of the 9 a.m. Sunday Mass, we can remain open longer. As it always has been in the past, your actions will be the determining factor of the future of the parish. I will keep you posted as we continue in the months after July. As always, feel free to contact me or any of your Council members with questions or comments.

Here's our *Catechism* paragraph for the week:

The mission of Christ and the Holy Spirit is brought to completion in the Church, which is the Body of Christ and the Temple of the Holy Spirit. This joint mission henceforth brings Christ's faithful to share in his communion with the Father and the Holy Spirit. The Spirit *prepares* men and goes out to them with his grace, in order to draw them to Christ. The Spirit *manifests* the risen Lord to them, recalls his word to them and opens their minds to the understanding of his Death and Resurrection. He makes present the mystery of Christ, supremely in the Eucharist, in order to reconcile them, to *bring them into communion* with God, that they may "bear much fruit (Jn. 15:8, 16)." (n. 737)

The Church sings a unique poetic "sequence" on various feasts throughout the year just before the Gospel is proclaimed. On Pentecost, the sequence is entitled Veni, Sancte Spiritu—Come, Holy Spirit. The poem asks the Holy Spirit to come and refresh our hearts. *Veni, Sancte Spiritu* has been sung on the feast of Pentecost since the 13th century. The poem consists of stanzas organized into three phrases—representing the Most Holy Trinity. Each phrase has seven syllables—representing the Seven Gifts of the Holy Spirit: wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, knowledge, piety, and fear of God.


