Don Antonio's Dispatch...

This weekend we celebrate the Most Holy Trinity. This belief, that God is one, and yet somehow also three Divine Persons, is one of the core teachings of Christianity, and separates us from the other major monotheistic religions, Judaism and Islam. We are still monotheistic (we believe in one God), but we believe that our one God is also a communion of Persons. Most of the ways that we try to explain it with the material world end up being heresies, so we simply profess this truth, knowing that our finite minds cannot totally comprehend our infinite God, but also grateful that God has revealed Himself to us as a Trinity.

This Friday I have taken the day off so that I can give the benediction at the 143rd Trooper Recruit School Graduation for the Michigan State Police. We'll have coverage for the 12:10 p.m. Mass at St. Matthew.

Saturday, Bishop Boyea will ordain 2 new priests for the Diocese of Lansing. I'll be there to assist and celebrate with the priests and lay faithful of the diocese. It's a great reminder for us all to pray for more vocations to the priesthood. We are blessed to have 2 young men from St. Matthew who will be entering seminary in the fall. Please also pray for them as they prepare to discern in a more direct way if God is calling them to serve the Church as priests.

Here's our Catechism paragraphs for the week:

The mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is the central mystery of Christian faith and life. It is the mystery of God in himself. It is therefore the source of all the other mysteries of faith, the light that enlightens them. It is the most fundamental and essential teaching in the "hierarchy of the truths of faith (*General Catechetical Directory*, 43)." The whole history of salvation is identical with the history of the way and the means by which the one true God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, reveals himself to men "and reconciles and unites with himself those who turn away from sin (*General Catechetical Directory*, 48)." (n. 234)

The Trinity is a mystery of faith in the strict sense, one of the "mysteries that are hidden in God, which can never be known unless they are revealed by God (*Dei Filius*, 4)." To be sure, God has left traces of his Trinitarian being in his work of creation and in his Revelation throughout the Old Testament. But his inmost Being as Holy Trinity is a mystery that is inaccessible to reason alone or even to Israel's faith before the Incarnation of God's Son and the sending of the Holy Spirit. (n. 237)
