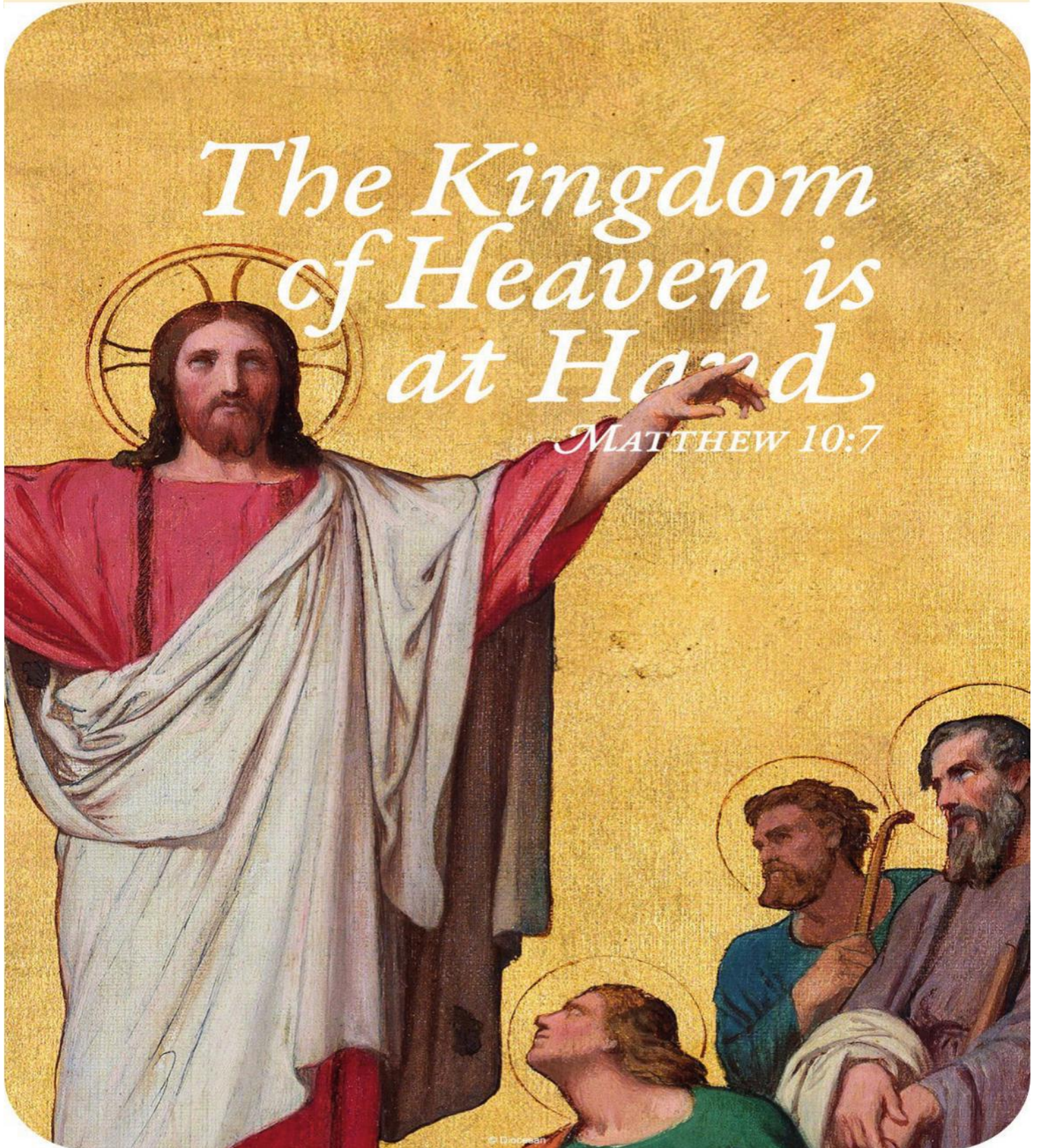

Don Antonio's Dispatch...

Happy Father's Day! May God bless all dads and, through the intercession of St. Joseph, may they help their families grow closer to God each day and become the saints that God wants all of us to be.

Saturday marks the celebration of the Nativity of St. John the Baptist. His is only one of three birthdays that the Church celebrates (along with the Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary, and the Nativity of our Lord). There is a tradition to have a bonfire on his feast day to celebrate St. John as the bright and shining light who heralded the presence of the Messiah. Of course, make sure it's legal to have a bonfire if you decide to celebrate in this way, and make sure things aren't too dry. But, this is a great way to bring the liturgical life of the Church into the life of your family, the domestic church.

Thanks to all our staff and volunteers who helped with Vacation Bible School this year, as well as the children who came to learn more about Jesus in the Eucharist. This is a great way for kids to grow in their faith, and I appreciate those who make it happen (attendees and workers).

Here's the *Catechism* paragraph for the week:

The whole Church is apostolic, in that she remains, through the successors of St. Peter and the other apostles, in communion of faith and life with her origin: and in that she is "sent out" into the whole world. All members of the Church share in this mission, though in various ways. "The Christian vocation is, of its nature, a vocation to the apostolate as well." Indeed, we call an apostolate "every activity of the Mystical Body" that aims "to spread the Kingdom of Christ over all the earth (*Apostolicam actuositatem*, 2)." (n. 863)

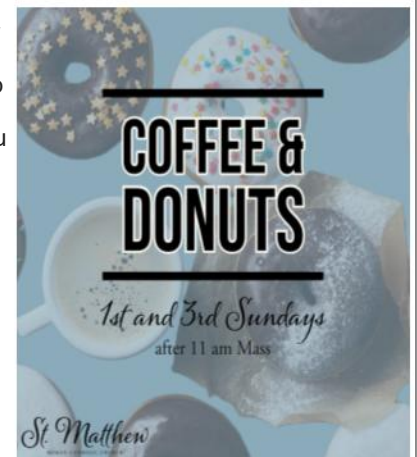

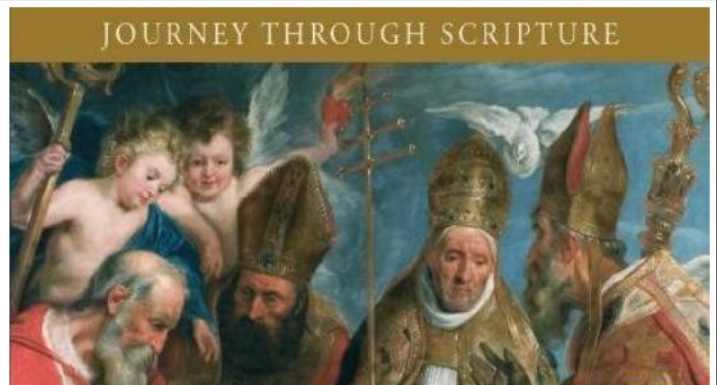
