

We are very blessed financially (without minimizing the struggles that so many families have in our State), and we share what we can, not that we become poor, but that all may have some, and our generosity may help the Church, just as others' generosity has helped our Church when it was starting out in the US. Also, and this news is a few weeks old, but congratulations to Glen Hart and Joseph Wilberding on being accepted as seminarians for the Diocese of Lansing! I personally am, and we as a parish are, very proud of you for discerning God's will to do more formal discernment of a vocation to the priesthood. While there are still many years ahead of you, know that we will pray for you to be open to God's will. I know, if God wills, they will be excellent priests. Here's our Catechism paragraph for the week:

Once our reason has grasped the idea of God's almighty power, it will easily and without any hesitation admit everything that [the Creed] will afterwards propose for us to believe—even if they be great and marvelous things, far above the ordinary laws of nature (*Roman Catechism*, I, 2, 13). 



"And sing the love amazing..."

The hymn "To Jesus Christ, Our Sovereign King" is a staple of Catholic hymnody. The hymn is relatively new and distinctly American. The text was written in 1941 by Msgr. Martin Hellriegel, a priest in Saint Louis, as a direct response to the pretensions of the Third Reich and to remind people who actually reigns eternal—our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. Of this text, the monsignor wrote, "I want Catholics to never forget the words of the Declaration of Independence: We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable Rights, that among these are Life, Liberty and the pursuit of Happiness." For the refrain, Msgr. Hellriegel quoted the ancient acclamation, "Christus vincit! Christus regnat! Christus imperat!" - "Christ conquers, Christ reigns, Christ commands"




