This weekend St. Matthew celebrates its parish patron. The Masses on Sunday will come from St. Matthew, not from the usual week in Ordinary Time (like St. Pius X will experience this weekend). St. Matthew is a great example of following the Lord when He calls us.

This week the priests of the Diocese of Lansing will be on Convocation. This is a time of fraternity, where we strengthen our bonds as priests, but also of formation, where we learn how to continue to grow in the virtues as priests. We will have Mass and Adoration on Monday, but there will be no Mass on Tuesday or Wednesday. I will work on having some prayer led by a deacon or a layperson (like Daytime Prayer and/or the Rosary). Please pray for us priests during this week!

Friday, 29 September, besides being the Feast of the Holy Archangels Sts. Michael, Gabriel, and Raphael, is also the anniversary of the establishment of St. Matthew parish. In 1911 St. Matthew parish was created to serve the growing Catholic population of Flint. Through ups and downs we have witnessed to the truth and love of the Gospel for 112 years. Here's to another 112 years of growing in our faith and sharing that faith with others!

Remember, lectors who want to continue as well as parishioners who want to be lectors need to be present for our refresher or training on Saturday after our Saturday confessions. I appreciate all those who volunteer in this important ministry.

Here's our Catechism paragraph for the week:

The economy of law and grace turns men's hearts away from avarice and envy. It initiates them into desire for the Sovereign Good; it instructs them in the desires of the Holy Spirit who satisfies man's heart.

The God of the promises always warned man against seduction by what from the beginning has seemed "good for food...a delight to the eyes...to be desired to make one wise (Gen. 3:6)." (n. 2541)



EMHCs help distribute the Body and Blood of Christ when there are not enough Ordinary Ministers of Holy Communion (deacons or instituted acolytes) present at Sunday and Holyday Masses.






