

Here we are in November! Once November starts, I feel like time speeds up until we arrive at the beginning of the new year. In the midst of this fast-paced time of year, may we make sure that we carve out time for God through daily prayer and adoration (when possible, especially on Mondays when we offer it). Even simply making the sign of the cross as you begin your day at work or a new task at home can sanctify that time.

Thursday the Church celebrates the Anniversary of the Dedication of the Papal Basilica of St. John Lateran, the pope's cathedral in Rome. It's a great day to renew our commitment to the one, holy, catholic, and apostolic Church which subsists in the Catholic Church, governed by the successor of St. Peter and the college of bishops.

Saturday is Veteran's Day, and though our veterans deserve more than just one day, it is fitting that we honor them. Without men and women putting their lives on hold by serving our country in the military, we would not be secure and safe with the freedoms we are so used to enjoying. God bless you, veterans, and the invaluable service you are providing or have provided for the United States of America!

Saturday we will also honor our volunteers at St. Matthew. We are still a small parish (though growing!), and while families give what they can in our offertory, we rely on many volunteers to do what larger parishes have staff members do. From leading a Bible study, to helping to clean our church, to bringing the Eucharist to those who cannot be with us on Sundays, to ushers, and many others, volunteers make our parish function. Thank you, volunteers, for the stewardship of your time and talent for the good of our beloved parish!

Here's our Catechism paragraph for the week:

"Prayer is the raising of one's mind and heart to God or the requesting of good things from God (St. John Damascene)." But when we pray, do we speak from the height of our pride and will, or "out of the depths (Ps. 130:1)" of a humble and contrite heart? He who humbles himself will be exalted; *humility* is the foundation of prayer. Only when we humbly acknowledge that "we do not know how to pray as we ought (Rom. 8:26)," are we ready to receive freely the gift of prayer. "Man is a beggar before God (St. Augustine of Hippo)." 





Saint Matthew, we sang the Gregorian chant "Kyrie" from Mass XI, which dates back to the Tenth Century. A visitor, who is not Catholic, took the time to write, "I had never experienced music like this before. I didn't know the words, but the music spoke to me." ("Kyrie eleison," by the way, is not Latin; it is Greek!) The Archbishop of San Francisco, Salvatore Cordileone, wrote: "In the times we're living in now, there's such a need for timeless beauty. This is what sacred music does. When people see and experience something beautiful, maybe they will do something similar in their lives."
