

Don Antonio's Dispatch...

I hope everyone had a good Thanksgiving with family and friends. Often, the weekend after Thanksgiving is the first Sunday of Advent, but this year we celebrate Christ the King, the last Sunday in Ordinary Time. The Church reminds us yearly to make Christ number one in our life, since all things belong to Him. May the Christ the King reign in our hearts and minds!

Thursday the Church celebrates the Feast of St. Andrew, the brother of St. Peter. St. Andrew is often referred to as the First-Called, as the Gospel of John has him as the first one that Jesus calls. St. Andrew is the patron of Scotland (whose flag incorporates the St. Andrew Cross, a cross shaped in the form of an X, on which he was crucified). So, for those of age, maybe enjoy a glass of scotch Thursday evening to celebrate this great Apostle (or you could eat haggis, if you so decide).

Here's the *Catechism* paragraph for the week:

Though already present in his Church, Christ's reign is nevertheless yet to be fulfilled "with power and great glory (Lk. 21:27)" by the King's return to earth. This reign is still under attack by the evil powers, even though they have been defeated definitively by Christ's Passover. Until everything is subject to him, "until there be realized new heavens and a new earth in which justice dwells, the pilgrim Church, in her sacraments and institutions, which belong to this present age, carries the mark of this world which will pass, and she herself takes her place among the creatures which groan and travail yet and await the revelation of the sons of God (Lumen gentium, 48 §3)." That is why Christians pray, above all in the Eucharist, to hasten Christ's return by saying to him: Marana tha! "Our Lord, come! (1 Cor. 16:22; Rev. 22:17, 20)." (n. 671)






