


Our offices will reopen on Tuesday, 26 December, though we do have some staff vacation that week, so please be patient if you're trying to get ahold of anyone at either parish.

to have started in the fourth century in Jerusalem. This celebration was observed by visitors from Rome who saw Christians in Jerusalem taking part in a midnight vigil to honor the birth of Jesus. The custom didn't take long to spread throughout the Roman Empire. At Saint Matthew, Mass will begin at 12 a.m., midnight, but you will want to be in church at 11:30 p.m. Christmas Eve. There will be a special prelude of carols in classic settings to prepare for the celebration of Holy Mass.


