

Merry Christmas! We are still in the Octave of Christmas, and we will be in the Christmas season through January 7. The twelve days of Christmas are the days of the Christmas season, not the days before Christmas. So let's continue to celebrate the Incarnation of the Lord.

Monday, 1 January is not a holyday of obligation this year. I will still have an Extraordinary Form Mass at 11 a.m. for those who would like to go to Mass and honor our Blessed Mother. Since it is not a holyday, there is no 12:10 p.m. Mass, but the offices will still be closed. We'll reopen for usual business on 2 January.

Friday night we'll be celebrating the 12th day of Christmas with the blessing of Epiphany Water (water that is blessed and exorcised in an extended and powerful way), followed by a potluck. All are welcome to join us. You can also bring water jugs so that you can have your own Epiphany water. The next morning, the traditional date of Epiphany (in the Ordinary Form is transferred to the Sunday after 1 January), we'll have our usual first Saturday Mass, though it will be a sung Mass.

Last, and not least, don't forget that St. Pius X is offering a free dinner for any St. Pius X parishioners on Saturday, 13 January. Tickets are free, but they are limited (due to occupancy restrictions). Please contact the office to get your tickets for this closing dinner.






