

Don Antonio's Dispatch...

This is an especially difficult week for St. Pius X parish. After almost 69 years of presence in Flint Township, the parish will close and the church will be de-consecrated. Bishop Boyea will celebrate the closing Mass, and I will concelebrate, probably with other priests of the Diocese of Lansing. After the church is de-consecrated, we will not have any other Masses or prayers in the church. The other buildings can still be used for activities, including our Food Pantry, Catechesis of the Good Shepherd, Divine Mercy and Catholic Men's Groups. However, this will happen as part of St. Matthew parish, who will take pastoral care for what used to be St. Pius X parishes.

I also want to thank all who helped with our Farewell Dinner, especially Diane Voto and Karen Downs. I hope all who attended found it a time to share memories and enjoy a last meal together as parishioners of St. Pius X.

Monday is Rev. Martin Luther King, Jr. Day, and our parish offices will be closed. We will, however, still have our usual Masses, Adoration, and Confession times. Let's continue to pray for an end to racism in all its forms!

Thursday also begins the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity. This is our yearly reminder that Christ desires all his followers to be united in truth and charity in the one Church He founded, which subsists in the Catholic Church (*Lumen gentium*, 8). Our unity cannot be based in eliminating difficult truths that the Holy Spirit has revealed to the Church, but in striving to understand and communicate those unchanging truths in better ways. Unity is always a work of the Holy Spirit, and cannot be achieved solely by our means. But we can cooperate with that work, and hopefully we can all do that, especially with our non-Catholic Christian friends. May we all be one in truth and charity!!

I also want to apologize for those of you who had to wait a while for me to respond to your requests/voicemails/emails/etc. This last week (and the week that I'm writing it, to be honest) have been quite occupied with work. I even cancelled my vacation, due to the necessity of my presence at different events. I appreciate your patience.




video presentation followed




