I pray that this coming week will find us letting go of some of our Hallmark fantasies for all things "merry and bright" in order to go deeper to ponder and embrace the depth of God's love and assurance of salvation above and beyond just the niceties of this season. Christmas is never disappointing and is always truly joy-filled when our hearts contemplate the profound but humble arrival of God-with-us in Jesus to definitively show that we are loved beyond our wildest contemplations. May this coming Christmas season not only be merry but also holy, peaceful, comforting, thrilling, and life-changing!

Repeated from last week

You may remember several years ago when a local megachurch canceled its Sunday services because Christmas (December 25) that year fell on a Sunday. Their leaders' original good intentions to suspend Sunday services so that their staff could spend the entire Christmas day with their families met with some local controversy and debate about how and when Christians should gather for our holiest of celebrations. No such debate exists in the Catholic Church. Christmas is a holy day not to be missed and every Sunday is a "little Easter," similarly not to be missed. In this weekend's bulletin you will find a schedule of Christmas Masses at St. Ann's. Since Christmas day falls on a Saturday and its special solemnity does not, like other lesser holy days, allow for abrogation, or suspension of the obligation to gather with the Christian community at Mass, we Christian Catholics will gather this year on Friday night (Christmas Eve) or Saturday morning (Christmas Day) AND THEN AGAIN on Sunday morning (Solemnity of the Holy Family). Taking into account that most will be with family on Saturday (Christmas Day), there will be no Saturday evening Mass of anticipation this year for Sunday, December 26. We hope this doesn't allow for any confusion but serves well to gather us twice in a few short hours to put our words into actions to "keep Christ in Christmas." Just think, next year will be simpler -- Christmas will fall on a Sunday and then we'll get a week until the following Sunday when Christ's grace and our commitment to being different than "the world" will compel us to Mass again. We can do this!
