- The supervision of Building Fund collections and expenditures for our *Light on a Hill! Capital Campaign*.
- Approving a less-expensive-than-originally-bid improvement to our church sound system.
- Utilizing our Building Maintenance Collections to make improvements such as rain gutters on the rectory, xeriscaping the west side of church property, and purchasing industrial mats outside the main entrances of the church to keep dust, mud, and snow salt from entering the church.

We want to thank new member **Geoff Phemister** for agreeing to serve and appreciate all the work and wisdom given by **Mike Leheska** whose place Geoff is filling. Please keep these good people in your prayers as they offer their gifts of counsel to the parish.

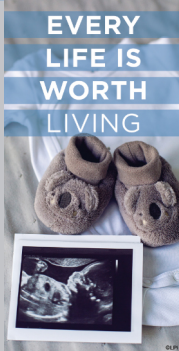
Good and gracious God, you blew into our nostrils the breath of life. You are the One to whom we owe our very existence.

### NEW HIGH SCHOOL FAITH FORMATION TOPIC

Parents of 9th and/or 10th grader: we are excited to announce that your students will begin a new series starting at the end of January called **YOU: Life, Love, and the Theology of the Body**. This program is based on a series of 129 of Pope St. John Paul II's Wednesday audiences from 1979 - 1984, in which he gave a profound and captivating explanation of marital love and sexual ethics, as well as a reassurance that God has a plan for each of us. Due to the delicacy and importance of these topics, there will be a required parent meeting in the 9th - 10th grade classroom on January 23rd from 10:15 - 11:15 a.m. At this meeting, parents will receive a parent's version of the student's workbook and an overview of the various topics covered throughout the semester. It is hoped that this program will empower you and your teens to faithfully live out the Church's teachings!
