Some updates from recent leadership meetings in the parish:  
\**Parish Pastoral Council* - The Council has surveyed the feedback from the parish Synodal meetings and agreed that the next year should be focused on three main areas in our parish: 1) Intentional outreach to the missing and forgotten in our parish family; 2) Multilevel communication in the parish, utilizing technology and other best practices; and 3) Making our youth ministry stronger and more visible in the life of the parish. They also suggested some summer activities (see the "Summer Surge" events elsewhere in this bulletin) and finalized our parish mission statement to be published and splashed around the parish premises in the near future.

\**Capital Campaign Committee* - While members of the committee continue to reach out to members of the parish from whom we haven't yet heard, there is a plan to soon re-present and remind the parish of the urgency of our building needs and the support needed to make the plans come to fruition. Currently the Building Committee and Finance Council await a more in-depth engineering study on the current parish hall to better determine costs for its renovation. Work continues - *our work on this Light on a Hill!*

\**Youth Committee* - A temporary committee to make recommendations for the future of youth ministry has studied some recent exhortations from Pope Francis on youth ministry, studied a proposed plan, met with Youth Coordinators Roman and Angela Asbill, and made some recommendations. We thank *Erica Knox, James Miller, Simon Leech, Andi Webb, and Meredith Zotter* for their service on this committee!

\**Finance Council* - These meetings are serious but easy due to the financial generosity of our parishioners. This last week's meeting was spent addressing the progress of the building campaign and doing preliminary work on the budget for the next fiscal year.

This weekend's election/selection will bring new members to the Parish Pastoral Council. We thank our past, current, and future members as well as every parishioner who agreed to serve if selected. May our parish move only as the Holy Spirit moves and guides us!
