Light on a Hill - Building Project Update

Members of our Building Committee have an ongoing concern that our parish is losing momentum in our Light on a Hill construction plans. The last few months have been spent waiting for pledges to come in and thinking about how we may need to adjust per the response of our Catholic community as well as the ongoing fluctuations in construction prices and interest rates. Last week our Building Committee and Finance Council met to decide what is to be done next. Below is an update:

Engineering Study: To understand whether and how our current parish hall will fit into our plans, a preliminary and then more extensive study was conducted. It was revealed that a complete renovation of the parish hall would necessitate substantial reinforcements of the structure. Even then, the ground underneath the concrete foundation would not be able to be remedied. The Building Committee has decided to retain the structure for the foreseeable future with just some cosmetic updates while we focus on new construction for what it is most needed in the near future. A prioritized list of which facilities are needed first and what can be built last will be decided as architectural drawings for the entire plan are processed.

-Architectural Drawings: The decision was made to move forward with the process of architectural drawings, using the architects from Dekker/Perich/Sabbatini in Amarillo. This is a lengthy process that will take into account the priority of needed facilities and guide the chosen contractor in details large and small involving construction timelines

-Construction Manager At-Risk: The consensus of the Committee and Council was to move forward with soliciting interest among the area construction firms to serve as our Construction Manager At-Risk. Once one is chosen by the Building Committee, this arrangement will put a contractor immediately in tandem with the architect to guide design and construction options with an emphasis on the parish's interest to get the best quality for the least money.

-The Campaign: We still have some progress to make to get all our parishioners to make a pledge to our campaign as well as to ask everyone to dig deeper to see how quickly and how much we can advance in our plans. We hope to reemphasize the campaign and seek new and bigger pledges throughout the month of September.

In the meantime, members of the Building Committee and I will seek every opportunity we can to meet with parish groups and host meetings to help as many of you, our parishioners, understand and get/ stay excited about what is in store for our parish by the will and guidance of our gracious God. Thank you to everyone for your patience as well as for your generosity in wanting our church to shine its light more brightly in our area.





# Youth Hike at Ceta Canyon


#### CAPITAL CAMPAIGN PRAYER
