### Easter Baptisms Next Weekend

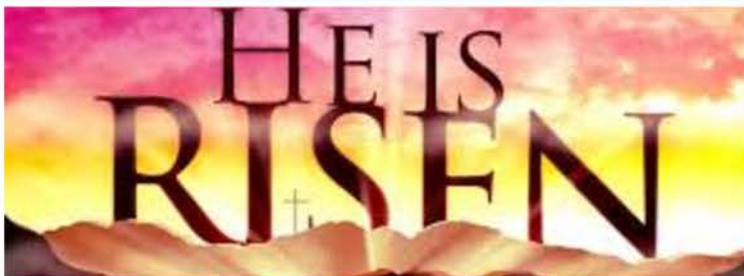

- Encouragement of all to practice works of mercy and charity, especially inviting inactive Catholics back to practice their faith. The spiritual and corporal works of mercy are:

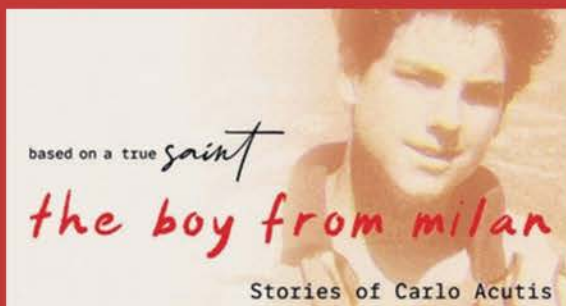
## Spiritual:

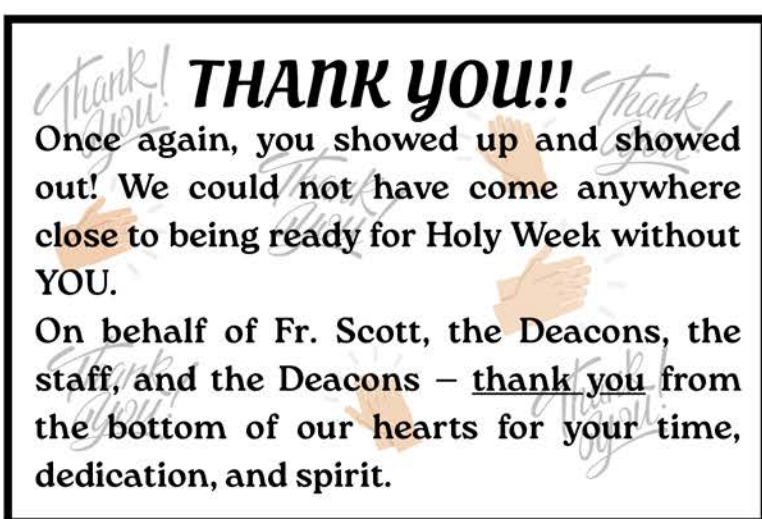
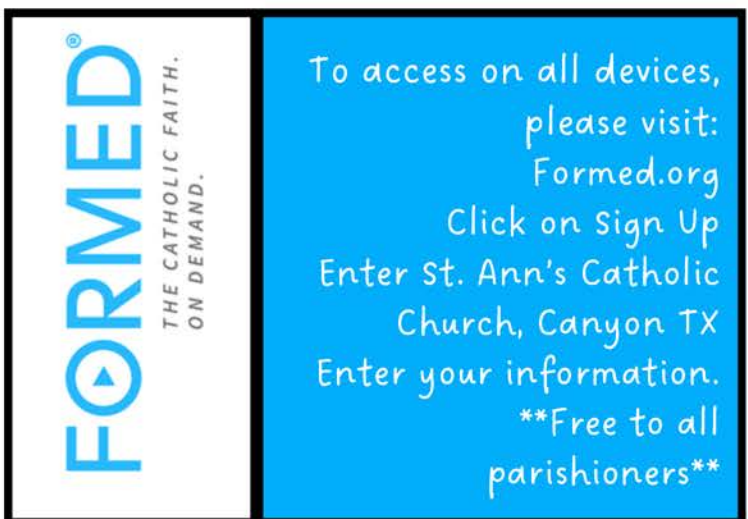
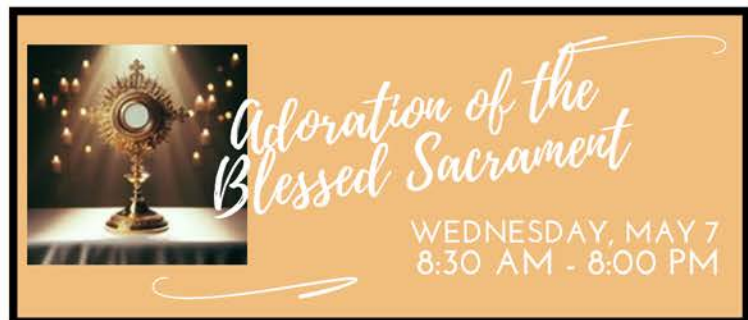
