- **Listen to God and Others:** Noted for his listening skills, the new pope is already urging us to build bridges by listening to each other rather than shouting at one another.
- **Let Faith Guide You:** His selection as pope, the first American, is a testament to the power of faith and its power to give us purpose in shared mission. Make faith — including prayer, going to Mass, nurturing Catholic friendships, and learning more — the central non-negotiable of your life.
- **Live the Authentic Gospel:** Pope Leo is aware of how many have watered down or twisted the Gospel for their own purposes. The Gospel of Christ and the Church's proclamation of it is the answer to our longings beyond the fads, the false, and the fake.
- **Serve Others:** Pope Leo's career as a missionary in Peru suggests a strong emphasis on service and compassion. He turned down Harvard to move to serve the poor. Graduates can use their skills to help those most in need.
- **Be Open to Change:** Pope Leo went from priest to pope in just ten years! His story encourages graduates to be open to the wisdom and inspiration that change brings, both intellectually and spiritually.

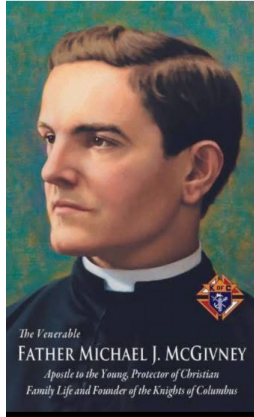
