Election/Selection Results

Thank you to everyone for taking the time to cast a ballot in last weekend's Parish Pastoral Council election/selection. There were 435 total ballots counted. The results of the process reflect the dictates of the Council Constitution: one with the most votes gaining a seat while the other names are put into a container and one name is blindly chosen by lot. This helps to make sure that both the voice of the people as well as the Holy Spirit's ability to surprise are reflected in the outcome. We welcome our newly elected or selected members, Randy Hochstein and David Rohrbach, and we thank all our great candidates for heeding the call to serve if so chosen. Our new members will join the rest of our Parish Pastoral Council for our May meeting this Thursday at 7 p.m.

If you're wondering why blue painter's tape is dangling from various surfaces in our newly constructed and renovated buildings, we have begun our "punch list" of things that need attention before the contractors fold up their ladders and move to their next project.
