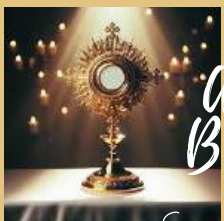

Greetings!

My name is Judah Asbill. I have been invited to be one of 150 Catholic young adults nationwide who will serve with NET Ministries. NET (*National Evangelization Teams*) is based in West St. Paul, MN, and since 1981, has sent out teams of young adults to travel across the United States to share their faith with youth through retreats and discipleship. NET Ministries will share the Gospel with 80,000 young people in the coming year!

From September to May, I will be in full-time active ministry with my NET Team, engaging with youth daily, helping lead retreats, giving talks, leading small groups, and sharing my faith with Catholic youth.

As a NET Missionary, **My personal sponsorship goal is to raise between \$7,000 & \$10,000** for this year of service. I **need between 20 and 30 donors** giving gifts ranging from \$100 - \$1,000 (or \$10 - \$100 per month). NET Ministries is a registered 501(c)(3) tax-exempt charitable organization, and all gifts to NET are tax deductible.
