If you and/or members of your family dedicated a brick back in 2005 when the church was dedicated, we will have the opportunity for community participation to repaint the black script so as to make them look "newish" again. These restored bricks will be laid in the new plaza along with the newly made bricks. This plaza will be a visible sign of Christ's welcoming love to the neighborhood and the community as well as of our willingness to welcome those who come to St. Ann's for the first or the umpteenth time.

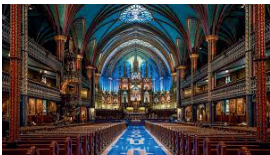
