As we now face paying off our debt, some generous leaders have intensified their giving. In the last week, a senior parishioner told me that she is giving \$20,000 more, a family paid off their pledge with a \$100,000 payment to beat the diocesan deadline for assessing donations to our building fund, a few more folks verified that even though they paid off their pledge some time ago, they've just continued paying every month until the debt is retired, another generous family gave \$150,000 more to boost our efforts to get everything paid off and to challenge others of means to do the same, and several bricks for our Welcoming Christ plaza have been donated. While most of us may not be able to give in the amounts above, every cent is important and every sacrificial gesture is appreciated. Thank you!

Please think and pray about buying a brick for our "Welcoming Christ" plaza planned for the front of the church (on the west side in between the bell tower and the porte cachere.) Brochures are located in all the gathering areas and information will appear in the bulletin for a while. If you and/or members of your family donated a brick back in 2005 when the church was dedicated, we will have the opportunity for community participation to repaint the black script so as to make them look "newish" again. These restored bricks will be laid in the new plaza along with the newly made bricks. This plaza will be a visible sign of Christ's welcoming love to the neighborhood and the community as well as of our willingness to welcome those who come to St. Ann's for the first or the umpteenth time.

#### From Glenn Backus, Director of The Market:

St. Ann's, through The Market on Tierra Blanca, is leading the way in feeding the hungry in our community. Since inception (January 9, 2024), The Market has:

- Served approximately 4,500 unduplicated households representing almost 10,000 household members.
- Served 368 unduplicated WT students who visited The Market 664 times.
- 68% of our clients have a Canyon mailing address and 26% are Seniors or older adults. 98% of our clients fall below the High Plains Food Bank poverty line.
- We have spent over \$171,000 on food, providing a retail value of over \$500,000 distributed to our clients.
- Our volunteers YOU have logged 10,500 hours since opening, delivering a dignified shopping experience to our clients.

Perhaps we're one step closer to hearing Jesus' words "Well done, good and faithful servant".???



# The Coming Christ

St. Ann's is excited to announce the commissioning of a new statue as we move into our renovated building and begin a new era. This statue, named Welcoming Christ, will be near the bell tower on a plaza of bricks purchased by parishioners. The statue is being made by Wiktor Szostalo, a Polish-American sculptor known for his stainless steel liturgical art. A former leader in Poland's Solidarity movement, he came to the U.S. as a political refugee in 1983 and settled in St. Louis. His work appears in churches and public spaces across the U.S. and abroad, including the Angel of Harmony at the St. Louis Cathedral.
