#### Support Our Schools

Do you know a teacher, aide, school administrator, or school staff member? Hopefully you have come to regard them as fellow human beings, good at heart, sincere in their intentions, deliberate about wanting to serve their communities and way-too-underappreciated. As we begin a new school year, I want to encourage this Christian community of St. Ann to defiantly stand against the strange wave of attacks against our educators that go beyond civil conversations about curricula and funding to personal accusations about the intentions, approach, and even faith lives of those WHO SERVE THE COMMON GOOD. These good men and women have chosen a path of service. We should give them the benefit of the doubt and encourage them as they work with our young people, even when we disagree with certain elements of the system. #### **New Candle Stands**

Several months ago one of the deacons brought to my attention that our brass candle stands were beyond shining up. The chemicals and elbow grease to shine them up was no longer up to the task. In use for a couple of decades, we decided to retire the brass candlestands but continue to use them for occasions that warrant extra stands. You'll notice the placement of newly crafted candlesticks in the sanctuary over the next several weeks. They were made in the Utah workshop of a permanent deacon who specializes in crafting furnishings for Catholic liturgical spaces. We hope that our beautiful church will continue to assist in the meeting of heaven and earth that happens in the Divine Liturgy.

#### **Construction Progress Continues**

Please notice that final steps are occurring in our construction project:

• The east parking lot work has begun and should take a week or so.

- The installation of new windows in the Parish Hall should begin this
- Support columns are being finished up on the south side of the Parish Hall. The north side of the Hall will begin thereafter, necessitating some patience as we hold Faith Formation classes around the mess and adjust our Parish Office hours.
- Renovation of the old Parish Hall bathrooms has been scheduled and plans are underway.
- More brick has been ordered for the courtyard to finish the circular wall.
   A landscape drip system has yet to be installed before a new tree is planted in the middle of the circle. Other landscaping will be done, the exterior of the Parish Hall will be painted, a fence completed around the playground, parking lot lighting connected, and other details finalized. And of course there's the "etc., etc."



Middle and high school years are critical time for teens to claim their faith as their own. Opportunities to explore the deep questions of life and faith, build Christ-centered friendships, become active participants in the Church. All programs, retreats and catechesis is designed to help our youth deepen their relationship with Jesus and live out their faith in the world.



Children in the younger foundational years are introduced to the beauty of God's love, the richness of Catholic tradition, and the joy of belonging to a faith community and begin to understand what it means to live as disciples of Christ.

Sacramental preparation years, First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion, are vital part of the faith journey. These sacraments mark key moments in a child's spiritual development, teaching them about God's mercy and their intimate union with Christ in the Eucharist.


1st and 2nd grade

Confirmation preparation is a central focus in 7th and 8th grades. Through this sacrament, our young people receive the gifts of the Holy Spirit, empowering them to live as bold witnesses to Christ.

These sacraments are not milestones to check off but are encounters with the living God. Therefore, sacramental preparation is a 2 year process and 75% attendance rate is required.


