

# NOVEMBER IS COMING, REMEMBERING OUR DECEASED LOVED ONES

Each November, St. Ann's continues the beautiful custom of remembering our departed loved ones in several special ways:

- Lighting candles and reading names of all whose funerals were celebrated at St. Ann's since last November I.
- Bringing photos of deceased loved ones to place on our Table of Remembrance near the baptismal font. These will remain there for the first several weekends of November.
- Writing names of loved ones who have died on the special November envelopes, which
  will be included in all November Masses. (An offering is optional; all proceeds will go
  to a charity designated by the pastor.)

Please bring pictures of your loved ones to the church the week of October 20-26, and plan to pick them up after Masses November 8-9.

Envelopes are available in the parish public areas and may be placed in the Sunday collection or turned in at the Parish Office before November begins, so your loved ones can be remembered at every Mass throughout the month.
