


Gone to Retreat

The priests of the diocese were surprised when our annual priests retreat, usually scheduled for the first week of November, was moved this year to the third week of December. Because of this change, please note that each of the daily Masses for December 16-19 will be celebrated at 8 a.m. instead of at the regular times. Please pardon the inconvenience.

Processing Meetings

Last week was a week of many meetings. Here are some highlights:

• Finance Council (November 18):

The building project debt was reviewed and stands at approximately \$1.75 million. People continue to generously contribute to the paydown of the debt and to paying additional payments beyond pledges that have already been paid. Both old mold from the old kitchen area and new mold in the Parish Office area will be remediated beginning in December, with St. Ann's responsible for 1/3 of the cost – approximately \$8500. A quontset hut cleanout and sale of stored items is slated for January. Hail damage from summer storms is being addressed. The rectory has a new roof. Replacement of the roof on the new building will be replaced by Wylie Hicks' insurers. The parish would like to purchase new chairs for the Parish Hall but is waiting to find a good deal.

• Parish Pastoral Council (November 20):

Discussion centered on the need to make St. Ann's a "vocations parish" through prayer, awareness, promotion, and other activities. Results of the six-year term evaluation for Fr. Scott were reviewed (see insert). The pace of the parish and its activities was briefly addressed as well as the upcoming ordination of Kevin Rickwartz, the departure of Deacon Joe and Karen Roder, as well as Advent and Christmas liturgies and events.

SACRAMENTAL GUIDELINES

Sacrament of Baptism

Parents seeking Baptism for their child(ren) {under 7} need to start with the following steps:

 Take and read one of the Baptism @ St. Ann's handouts located in the church Narthex and the Parish Office, or printable from our website: stannsofcanyon.org. Then, to register for Baptism, parent(s) should attend a Baptism Registration Meeting, held after each Mass on the third weekend of the month. This session will provide you with everything else you will need to know.

Sacrament of Confirmation

Celebrated with students in the 8th grade (or older) every year during the Easter season. Students must have regularly attended Wednesday evening or Sunday morning Faith Formation classes in 7th and 8th grades, be currently enrolled and participating in St. Ann's Faith Formation, and participate in the Confirmation preparation program.

Sacrament of Marriage

Please call the Parish Office at least six months in advance for an initial meeting with the pastor. All couples are required by the Diocese of Amarillo to complete pre-marital and Natural Family Planning classes. After they have fulfilled these requirements, a follow-up meeting with the parish liturgy coordinators is scheduled to finalize plans for the wedding.

Sacrament of Penance

Saturdays, 3:00 - 4:30 p.m. or by appointment.

Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick

Offered the first weekend of the month after all Masses. Please contact the Parish Office if you or a loved one are in need of this sacrament. A priest-chaplain is available at all of the hospitals in Amarillo, but Catholics and/or their families should make the request.
