

LANDINGS is an eight-week program that offers "a safe place to land," a place for listening and for being heard, a place for asking questions and for reconnecting with the faith as an adult. Confirmation for Adults

St. Ann's is offering a 10-hour catechesis class for adults who already receive the Eucharist but have not received the Sacrament of Confirmation. If you fall into this category and are interested in participating please contact Jennifer Sperry at dre@stannsofcanyon.org or call 806-655-3302 by Friday, January 23, 2026.

Please note in order to participate in this program and receive the Sacrament of Confirmation the candidate must:

- Contact the Parish Office for an interview with our DRE, Jennifer Sperry
- Be out of High School and at least 18 years old
- Be able to commit to 10 hours of catechesis before Confirmation and at least 3 hours after reception of Confirmation.
- Provide a copy of their Baptismal Certificate
- If married, provide a copy of the Church's certificate of the Sacrament of Matrimony
- Understand the person he/she has chosen to be the sponsor fulfills all the requirements as stated in Canon Law.
