As we begin this new semester, I would like to remind families of the importance of regular attendance in Faith Formation classes. Each week valuable information is taught and when a child misses class, gaps in learning can occur.

For students preparing to receive sacraments, attendance is especially important. These students are required to meet a 75% attendance requirement, which allows for no more than 7 absences for two consecutive years—both the year prior and the year they are receiving a sacrament.

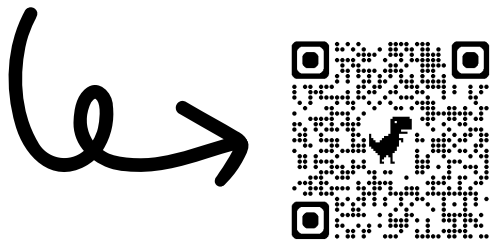
