Different Fridays -- Different Stations

Like most Catholic parishes, our St. Ann's community gathers every Friday during Lent for devotional prayers connected to the Stations of the Cross. Tracing the devotion's origins to the early Church for Christians who could not make a pilgrimage to the Holy Land to visit the actual spots where Jesus walked His way of the cross, the Stations involve meditation and movement and can be prayed individually or in small or large gatherings. While many of us are accustomed to the prayers of more traditional Stations of the Cross such as those composed by St. Alphonsus Ligouri, there are many and various versions of the Stations, from meditations that focus on the perspective of the Virgin Mary, to those focused on the suffering of the world, to those composed by popes and spiritual writers, etc. This year St. Ann's will journey through various of versions, appreciating how Jesus's cross illumines and informs a variety of lived experiences. Come and pray with us this Lent on Fridays at 6 p.m. in the church to discover or rediscover this beautiful Catholic devotion.
