The Good, the Bad, and the UCA

Friends, it's that time of year again. For years our Diocese of Amarillo, the Catholic people in the Texas Panhandle dispersed over a large, rural area but a united family of faith, has depended on the annual United Catholic Appeal to finance our diocesan ministries and administration. This year is no different.

The Good: We have new bishop – a Cardinal! – whom Pope Leo XIV has sent to help us bridge the time between the retirement of our last bishop and the appointment of a new bishop. There is hope in the air and Cardinal DiNardo has already brought about some great changes in his short time with us. He would appreciate our UCA support.

The Bad: For the first time in a long time, we did not meet our UCA goal last year. Our goal for 2025/2026 was \$109,588. We pledged \$107,624.17. But we've only paid \$94,270.06 of our pledges. Unless we catch up these last few weeks of the fiscal year, ***St. Ann's will have to pay approximately \$15,000 to the diocese out of our parish savings*** to make up for our inexplicable underperformance.

The UCA: Over the next few weeks, your attention will be directed to the many opportunities to pledge to support our diocesan church. Watch for bulletin announcements, Flocknotes, a video from Cardinal DiNardo, a letter to your home address, pledge cards in the Narthex, and our pledge weekend May 30 & 31. We need you: those who have pledged in the past, those who have never pledged, and those who are new to our parish. Our UCA goal this year is ***\$120,446***. Let's get over our goal and not under it, especially in this 100th anniversary year of our diocese!

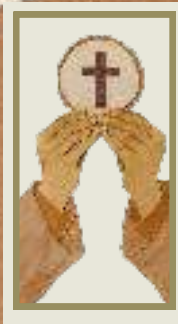

Anointing of the Sick

New Guidelines

The Church promulgated a new Rite of Anointing of the Sick on Easter Sunday of this year. The new Rite makes some theological adjustments, reminding the Church of the power of redemptive suffering, the sacrament's importance, and also the centrality of the Eucharist brought to and received by those beset by the suffering that illness presents. To be more faithful to the Rite's integrity, our parish will make some adjustments. Instead of offering Anointing every month after weekend Masses, we will offer an Anointing liturgy every other month, twenty minutes before each weekend Mass in the Blessed Sacrament Chapel. Our first celebration of this Rite will be the weekend of June 13-14. Stay tuned for details. Of course, Anointing can be requested anytime when someone is facing a serious surgery or is seriously ill.
