

"Rejoice! or 'Why is Father wearing pink??"

Today is Gaudete Sunday, a name taken from the first word of the Entrance Chant in Latin. Gaudete means *Rejoice!* And, so, today affords

us the opportunity to check in and see how we've been doing with our *Rejoice!* advent meditations. How have the past two weeks been for us as we have been praying with Sacred Scripture through the heart of St. Joseph? How has the Lord begun to change my mind and heart? Have I been faithful to daily prayer? If we have fallen off already, have no fear! We still have two weeks left to re-enter into this sacred time and begin again.

Thus Gaudete Sunday affords us a chance to regroup and recalibrate ourselves. As a sort of mid-point in our four weeks journey, the Church allows a little more *joy* to enter into our otherwise penitential season of Advent. Hence sanctuaries today usually enjoy a bit more floral arrangements, and the sacred ministers have the option of donning *rose* (not pink!) vestments.

Why rose?

I have yet to stumble upon an "official" answer to this question (perhaps our famed Deacon can unearth this mystery for us in the future). Nevertheless, there are two explanations that I have heard that make enough sense to me. First, rose is in some sense a brighter form of violet. So it can be seen as the white of Christmas coming so close so as to shine through the violet, giving us hope that the coming of the Lord is very near. Second, if we imagine the violet of Advent as symbolizing the darkness of night before the coming of the light of Christ then rose would symbolize the soft, fiery glow of dawn as Christ draws near.

STUMP THE DEACON!

Can I receive Communion more than once a day?

In most instances, you can receive Communion twice a day, as long as the second time is at a Mass. Canon Law paragraph 917 states, "A person who has already received the Most Holy Eucharist can receive it a second time on the same day only within the Eucharistic celebration in which the person participates, without prejudice to the prescript of can. 921, §2." (Can. 921, §2 states that those in danger of death are urged to receive Communion even if they had received Holy Communion earlier in the day). Paragraph 917 was a change from the 1917 Code of Canon Law that forbade the reception of Communion more than once except in danger of death.

A "second time" means only twice. The New Commentary on the Code of Canon Law states, "In 1984 the Pontifical Commission for the Authentic Interpretation of the Canons of the Code of Canon Law issued an authentic interpretation of this canon to clarify that the word iterum as used here means 'a second time,' not "again and again' as often as one participates in the Eucharist. Only as Viaticum [Holy Communion to be received by a dying person], or in the case of the priest who has permission to trinate (celebrate Mass three times in one day), may anyone receive communion a third time in one day. The purpose of this law is twofold: on the one hand, to promote active participation in the Eucharist including full sacramental sharing in the Lord's body and blood; on the other hand, to prevent the abuse of multiple receiving communions superstition, ignorance, or misguided devotion."

So, yes, you may receive Communion twice a day as mentioned above. There could be several reasons for this, including attending a second Mass to help a young parent with their children at Mass, or attending a funeral Mass or a wedding Mass. Feel free to receive Holy Communion in these cases, as long as you are in the state of grace and have observed the fasting requirements.

With a blessing, they will leave the assembly after the homily, and they will continue instruction with a catechist. This dismissal is a powerful sign and public witness to the community of faith of the sincerity and determination of those seeking to become Catholic. It shows that they are seriously pursuing their call and preparing to become full-fledged, committed Catholics. The Catechumenate phase will resume **January 2**. 
