Taylor, I am very pleased to announce that perpetual adoration will be resuming after the 6:00 p.m. Mass on Sunday, February 13th! I know that this is the weekend of the Super Bowl, however, it was the best time to start in preparation for Lent. If you turn to page 6 of the bulletin, you will notice that we are still in need of people to volunteer for certain hours, especially at night. For full disclosure, Fr. Taylor and I have taken the 11:00 p.m. to 12 Midnight hour on Tuesdays. So, if you have not signed up for an hour, please prayerfully consider it. STUMP THE DEACON!

I noticed that sometimes during Mass we recite the Nicene Creed and other times we recite the Apostles' Creed. Why the change?

The revised Roman Missal now gives permission to use either creed during Sunday Mass. However, the normal routine is to use the Nicene Creed during most of the year and the Apostles' Creed during Lent and Easter time. The reason for this is that the Apostles' Creed is more associated with baptism. During Lent and Easter time, the elect are preparing for baptism, and many will be baptized at the Easter Vigil. The Nicene Creed is more associated with the Eucharist.

According to the *General Instruction of the Roman Missal*, the purpose of the Creed "is that the whole gathered people may respond to the word of God proclaimed in the readings taken from Sacred Scripture and explained in the homily, and that they may also call to mind and confess the great mysteries of the faith by reciting the rule of faith in a formula approved for liturgical use before these mysteries are celebrated in the Eucharist. The Creed is to be sung or said by the priest together with the people on Sundays and solemnities. It may be said also at particular celebrations of a more solemn character" (§ 67 and 68).

According to EWTN, *Substituting for the Creed*, "The Creed may not normally be omitted on any Sunday Mass except as indicated below:

- During the Easter Vigil and on Easter Sunday (but not on other Sundays of Easter Season), the renewal of baptismal promises and sprinkling with holy water replaces the Creed.
- This is to emphasize the traditional connection of Easter Sunday with baptism, and because the profession of faith is included in the baptismal promises.
- Likewise, whenever baptism or confirmation is celebrated during Mass, the profession of faith is omitted because the baptismal promises are either made or renewed during the rite."

According to liturgical guidelines, neither Creed is proclaimed on most weekday Masses, except on solemnities such as on holy days of obligation, the Nativity of St. John the Baptist, and the feast of St. Peter and Paul.
