



Christ's peace to all of you!

It is a joy and a privilege to join the family of believers here at Immaculate Conception and the Mission of the Sacred Heart as a spiritual father and to assist Father Matthew in providing for the spiritual needs of the parish. I look forward to getting to know as many of you as time and energy will allow, so to facilitate that, here is a little to know about me.

I was born in Baton Rouge and grew up in Gonzales, Louisiana. My father, Richard, taught in the public school system for many years as a music teacher and band director before retiring. My mother, Mary, is a pianist and piano teacher. So as you can imagine, the house I grew up in was a musical one! I have three sisters, all of whom live in the Baton Rouge area, and 12 nieces and nephews (number 13 on the way)! My "home parish" growing up was St. Theresa of Avila; however, both of my parents being church musicians, I spent significant time at St. Gabriel Catholic Church and at St. John the Evangelist, where in high school I was a member of the choir at the 9:30 mass.

I attended East Ascension for high school, where my main extracurricular was, shockingly, marching and concert band. I went on to LSU for college, where my love for math, science, and learning in general led me to major in Civil Engineering (yes, another engineer-priest...). While at LSU, I became involved, through God's provident working, at the Catholic Student Center on campus, Christ the King, first in attending Bible studies, then leading them, then just being around for whatever was going on and helping wherever needed. I had first heard a faint glimmer of the call to the priesthood in high school, which I spent several years running away from. Through my involvement at Christ the King, and the many vital and lifegiving relationships that formed there, Our Lord was able, slowly, to break down the walls I had put up to keep Him out, and show me in no uncertain terms that a deeper relationship with Him, trusting in His plan, was the surest way to the peace and happiness that I was longing for.

As I was preparing to graduate LSU, I answered His call to enter seminary and begin formally discerning the diocesan priesthood. My time in seminary was one of deep blessing and transformation, and I am overjoyed to have the opportunity to share the message of reconciliation and salvation that Our Lord has sent me to proclaim. But I am also man, beset by my own weaknesses and shortcomings, and so I ask for your prayers as I come to your parish, that I may always be found a faithful steward of the ministry which God, in love for His people, has entrusted to me. May He from whom and for whom all things are bless each of you today and always.

## The Comboni Missionaries of the Heart of Jesus

The Mission Appeal will be the weekend of July 22 and 23 at all Masses

The Comboni Missionaries of the Heart of Jesus were founded in 1867 by Saint Daniel Comboni, the first Bishop of Central Africa. Today, the Comboni Missionaries number close to 1,500, with an equal number of Comboni Missionary Sisters. Together, they serve in over forty countries in Africa, Europe, the Americas and Asia. The Comboni Missionaries remain true to their original calling as missionaries, and often serve where the Church is new and where people are just forming their Christian identity. They also serve in marginalized communities, including in some of the most impoverished places on Earth. Their parishes can be the size of American states, or within the slums of the developing world. Emphasis is given to evangelization, and to service to people who are poor many of whom have no place else to turn.

Funds collected through the Missionary Cooperative Plan are directed to projects in Africa and Latin America to evangelize, to educate (especially girls and young women), and to create better living conditions, such as through clinics and the provision of clean water. Beneficiaries range from street vendors in Peru to the Pygmies in the Central African Republic to desert dwellers in Ethiopia, Eritrea and Kenya.

In North America, the Comboni Missionaries have a contingent of 30 members in Chicago, Cincinnati, Los Angeles, San Bernardino, Newark and Hamilton, Ontario. Their North American Mission Center is at 1318 Nagel Road, Cincinnati, OH 45255.

**Fr. Maciek Zielinski, MCCJ** is a Comboni Missionary from Poland currently working in Kenya. He was ordained Priest in 2008 and for some years worked in Poland as a Vocation Promoter. Then in the beginning of 2014 was sent to Kenya where he served in first evangelization around Pokot (North – West Kenya). Currently he works in Nairobi.

#### **Youth Ministry News Special Collection**

The ICC Youth Ministry invites Middle Schoolers in grades 6-8 and High Schoolers in grades 9-12 to join together in fellowship, fun, and faith, (and to eat food). Throughout the year, there are various activities and events that allow the youth to form a deeper relationship with Christ, and develop authentic friendships with others in our parish and diocese.

This past school year, the Middle Schoolers met monthly for food, games, and fellowship. They also attended MP3 at St. Michael's High School with other youth from our Diocese and hiked at Tunica Falls.

The High Schoolers have attended Diocesan-wide events, including the March for Life trip to Washington D.C., Steubenville South Conference/Retreat in Alexandria, and several MP3's at St. Michael's High School. They also do a mix of fun and service projects throughout the year, including the Car Wash for Life, Stations of the Cross, Breakfast with St. Nick, holiday parties, hiking at Tunica Falls, and game nights.

This summer, we had 25 High School Students attend the Steubenville South Conference/Retreat in Alexandria that happened at the end of June. Events such as Steubenville South and the March for Life cost a significant amount of money per child. The March for Life costs approx. \$700 per student, and Steubenville South costs approx. \$350 per student. We only ask the families to pay a small amount of this total, therfore we need help to cover the rest of the costs so we can continue providing these events this upcoming year for the students.
