Here at Saint John Paul II our weekly contributions to the general collection support the day-to-day operating expenses of the parish, including faith formation, Catholic education, liturgy, maintaining our facilities and person-

Dear Parishioners

Each year at this time, we are encouraged to consider the needs of our Church beyond our parish boundaries—to consider the needs of our diocese as one family in Christ. Once a year we are asked to make a commitment through Annual Diocesan Appeal (ADA) to support the work of our diocesan programs and ministries that provide services that no one parish could provide on its own. After receiving a letter from the diocese about the 2017 ADA, I sent a request to Bishop Jenky to reduce our 2017 ADA goal which was \$63,599 and I went to Peoria to meet with

him and his two Vicars General. I was told that the Bishop does not usually reduce ADA goals since this would establish a difficult precedent. However, as I continued presenting my case and defending it with what we are already doing here at Saint John Paul II parish including our Capital

The ADA is the major source of revenue for the programs and agencies of the Diocese of Peoria. These programs and agencies enable the Church in the Diocese of Peoria, under the leadership of Bishop Daniel Jenky, to reach across parish boundaries to provide services in the areas of Prayer and Worship, care for the elderly, prison ministry, food and clothing for those who go without, Christian Education (Catholic Schools and Parish Religious Education), Evangelization, Pre-Cana for our engaged couples, Vocation Enrichment, and many others.

2017 ADA goal has been lowered due to the outstanding support given to Saint John Paul II Parish and Visitation Catholic School through many outlets; such as Our Capital Campaign, donations to Security System and school aid etc.

Appeal Weekend is April 8 & 9

Campaign which is going on right now, Bishop Jenky decided to carefully consider my request. asked one of the Vicars General to work with the finance office and reexamine more closely the various numbers which are used in the ADA goal formula. Upon further resome adjustments were view, made and the calculation was refigured. The office of the finance suggested that 15% minimum cap be reduced from last year's goal which was \$55,259. Bishop Jenky approved change of 2017 ADA parish goal from \$63,599 to \$46,969. This lower ADA goal is the result of the re-examination of the figures used for determining the ADA goals. Those figures are from your support to Saint John Paul II Parish and Visitation Catholic School. Thank you for your generosity.
