Baptism: All baptisms will take place at Visitation Church the 1st & 3rd Sunday after 9:00 a.m. Mass (except during Lent). Please call the parish office to schedule a time. A free-will donation should be given to the clergy performing the baptism. Additionally, non-members will be charged \$50. Baptism classes are the 3rd Sunday @ 10:00 a.m. in English and the 4th Sunday @ 8:00 a.m. in Spanish.

<u>Marriage</u>: Contact the Pastor at least 6 to 12 months in advance to schedule a wedding and begin marriage preparations.

**Reconciliation**: Saturday, from 4:00 p.m.—4:40 p.m. in the Church or call the Parish office for an appointment.

<u>Visitation & Anointing of the Sick</u>: Any person home-bound, hospitalized, in the nursing home or advanced in years may notify the Parish Office to receive the Sacraments: Eucharist, Confession/Reconciliation and Anointing of the Sick. Parishioners from the Pastoral Care Ministry would be glad to visit. We also offer Friday Communion Calls to the Homebound. Please call the Parish Office if you or someone you know would like to be visited monthly.
