Saint John Paul | Pastoral Care Ministry consists of a group of dedicated parishioners. This group administers Holy Communion to the homebound and to those in hospitals and nursing homes.

Pastoral Care members administer the Eucharist to home bound parishioners the first Friday of each month. They celebrate Moly Communion at Court yard Village each Monday. The Pastoral care members divide into groups of two and visit the nursing homes at other times. These visits allow residents to join in prayer. Residents also have the opportunity to hear about and feel a part of our Catholic Community. Thus, Pastoral Care members serve as a liaison between the Church and our homebound.
