

SAINT ANDREW SCHOOL DRESS CODE

BOYS GRADES 1-8

- Light grey dress slacks with belt
- White dress shirt and uniform tie. Shirts must be tucked in at all times. Only solid white t-shirts may be worn under the dress shirt.
- Prescott red vest or sweater (with school logo)
- Black or grey dress socks or solid white socks. Ankle socks are not permitted.
- Black/brown/blue/grey lace-up or buckle-style shoes with a non-skid and non-marking sole. Slip-on styles are not permitted. Sneakers may only and must be worn on gym days.

Optional Spring/Fall Items

- Light grey walking shorts with belt in place of dress slacks
- Golf shirt (white or red) with school logo. Only solid white t-shirts may be worn under the SAS golf shirt. Shirts must be tucked in at all times.
- White ankle socks may be worn ONLY with the shorts.
- If a student opts to wear the SAS golf shirt, the uniform sweater may be omitted. *Please note that ONLY the uniform sweater is permitted to be worn in the classroom for warmth.*

GIRLS

Grades 1-4

- Knee-length plaid jumper with white blouse with round “Peter Pan” collar
- Prescott red cardigan sweater with school logo
- Only solid white t-shirts may be worn under the blouse.

Grades 5-8

- Knee-length plaid kilt with white button-down oxford blouse. Only solid white t-shirts may be worn under the blouse. Shirts must be tucked in at all times. Kilts may not be rolled at the waist.
- Prescott red crew neck or v-neck sweater with school logo

All girls wear ONLY prescott red knee socks OR black, prescott red, or navy tights. All girls wear black/brown/blue/grey lace-up or buckle-style shoes with a non-skid and non-marking sole. Slip-on styles are not permitted. Sneakers may only and must be worn on gym days.

Optional Spring/Fall Items Grades 1-8

- Light grey walking shorts OR navy skort in place of the jumper or kilt
- Golf shirt (white or red) with school logo. This may be worn with the kilt, shorts or skort, but not with the jumper. Shirts must be tucked in at all times. Only solid white t-shirts may be worn under the SAS golf shirt.
- White ankle socks may be worn ONLY with the shorts or skort.
- If a student opts to wear the SAS golf shirt, the uniform sweater may be omitted. *Please note that ONLY the uniform sweater is permitted to be worn in the classroom for warmth.*

GYM UNIFORM - BOYS & GIRLS GRADES 1-8

- Navy sweatpants and sweatshirt with school logo, grey t-shirt with SAS cardinal logo. Shirts must be tucked in at all times.
- Sneakers MUST be worn on gym days with white or black solid color socks only.

Optional Spring/Fall Gym Uniform Items

- Navy mesh shorts with school logo in place of sweatpants

KINDERGARTEN - BOYS & GIRLS

- All students wear navy sweatpants and sweatshirt with school logo and the golf shirt (white or red) with school logo, with lace-up sneakers and solid white or black socks. Shirts must be tucked in at all times.

Optional Spring/Fall Items

- Navy mesh shorts with school logo may be worn in place of navy sweatpants.

PRE-K FOR 3- & 4-YEAR-OLDS

- There is no uniform for pre-K students. Please dress your child in comfortable, appropriate clothing. Shoes must be closed-toe; sneakers are strongly encouraged. Slip-on styles are not permitted. On gym day, all students must wear sneakers and pants.

The optional Spring/Fall uniform items may only be worn with permission of the Principal. The Principal determines the start and end dates for these uniform pieces.

During the spring and early fall days of inconsistent temperatures, we ask parents to use their best judgment regarding which uniform to wear to school. The standard uniform may always be worn if the weather is too cool for the optional items. We also ask that you send your child to school with outerwear that is appropriate for the weather and the season.

SAINT ANDREW SCHOOL DRESS CODE

HAIR

- Hair cuts and styles must be traditional, conservative, and appropriate. Extreme hair styles are not permitted. Boys' hair must be cut above the ears and above the collar. Final determination as to what is traditional, conservative, and appropriate is decided by the administration.
- Hair coloring, including highlighting, is not permitted.
- Facial hair is not permitted.
- Hair accessories must be conservative and minimal in size. Bandanas and head scarves are not permitted. Students may not wear hats inside school buildings.

JEWELRY

- Earrings: Only girls are permitted to wear earrings. Girls may wear one pair only of post earrings that are no larger than a dime. Dangling or hoop earrings are not permitted. Boys are not permitted to wear earrings.
- Piercings: No jewelry associated with any body piercings may be worn by any students (including nose piercings, tongue piercings, or cartilage ear piercings).
- Necklaces: Both girls and boys may wear a religious medal around the neck, but it must remain under the uniform shirt at all times. No other necklaces/neck jewelry are permitted.
- Watches: Apple watches or any other "smart" wrist device with messaging are not permitted.
- Bracelets and rings are not permitted.
- NO JEWELRY OF ANY KIND IS PERMITTED ON GYM DAY.

MAKE-UP AND NAIL POLISH

- Students are not permitted to wear make-up, colored nail polish, fake nails, or tips.
