From the First Apology in Defense of the Christians by St. Justin, Martyr

No one may share the Eucharist with us unless he believes that what we teach is true, unless he is washed in the regenerating waters of baptism for the remission of his sins, and unless he lives in accordance with the principles given us by Christ

We do not consume the eucharistic bread and wine as if it were ordinary food and drink, for we have been taught that as Jesus Christ our Saviour became a man of flesh and blood by the power of the Word of God, so also the food that our flesh and blood assimilates for its nourishment becomes the flesh and blood of the incarnate Jesus by the power of his own words contained in the prayer of thanksgiving.

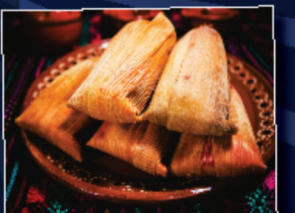

From the Pastor

My Dear Brothers and Sisters in the Lord:

The annual Parish Festival is just around the corner. Thanks to the dedication of a great team of volunteers, preparations for the festival are well underway. Your help is needed to make this year's event a success. I invite you to speak to one of the volunteers at the flagpoles after Mass, or to go to the festival website: www.SeasCatholicFestival.org, where you can sign-up to give your time.

This time of the year also marks the beginning of our First Holy Communion celebrations. There are nearly 600 children and young people who will receive the Lord in the Holy Eucharist in the weeks ahead. I commend their parents for participating in their religious formation and to our wonderful group of CCE staff, catechists, and volunteers who have dedicated themselves so generously in helping prepare these young souls for such an important moment in their lives.

The Eucharist does not exist without the Holy Mass. *The Catechism of the Catholic Church* teaches that the Mass is "the sacramental offering of [Christ's] unique sacrifice" (CCC, no. 1362). In commanding the Church to "do this in remembrance of me" (Luke 22:19), Jesus declared his intention that the Mass become the center and root of the Church's life and that of every Christian.

The authenticity of our Christian witness is rooted in Jesus, and that means that it is rooted in the Holy Eucharist and the Holy Mass. We ought to cultivate the expectation that participating in the Sunday Mass (and on Holy Days too, of course) is simply the normal thing that Catholics do. Anything less is abnormal. Even if on a particular Sunday someone is ill or unexpectedly prevented from participating in Mass, nothing should deviate from that standard.

The Catechism also reminds us that willful negligence of Sunday Mass can lead to indifference, ingratitude, lukewarmness, spiritual laziness, and eventually, hatred of God (cf. CCC, no. 2094). The remedy for these spiritual sicknesses is simple: the reverent and consistent participation in the Holy Mass, which is within the reach of all of us.

We should never forget that God loves us and wants to share his life with us: here on earth, and in his heavenly kingdom. The Holy Mass is a sacrificial offering of gratitude for this gift. May we always be faithful to this divine favor.

The apostles, in their recollections, which are called gospels, handed down to us what Jesus commanded them to do. They tell us that he took bread, gave thanks and said: Do this in memory of me. This is my body. In the same way he took the cup, he gave thanks and said: This is my blood. The Lord gave this command to them alone. Ever since then we have constantly reminded one another of these things. The rich among us help the poor and we are always united. For all that we receive we praise the Creator of the universe through his Son Jesus Christ and through the Holy Spirit.

On Sunday we have a common assembly of all our members, whether they live in the city or the outlying districts. The recollections of the apostles or the writings of the prophets are read, as long as there is time. When the reader has finished, the president of the assembly speaks to us; he urges everyone to imitate the examples of virtue we have heard in the readings. Then we all stand up together and pray.

On the conclusion of our prayer, bread and wine and water are brought forward. The president offers prayers and gives thanks to the best of his ability, and the people give assent by saying, "Amen." The Eucharist is distributed, everyone present communicates, and the deacons take it to those who are absent.

The wealthy, if they wish, may make a contribution, and they themselves decide the amount. The collection is placed in the custody of the president, who uses it to help the orphans and widows and all who for any reason are in distress, whether because they are sick, in prison, or away from home. In a word, he takes care of all who are in need.

We hold our common assembly on Sunday because it is the first day of the week, the day on which God put darkness and chaos to flight and created the world, and because on that same day our savior Jesus Christ rose from the dead. For he was crucified on Friday and on Sunday he appeared to his apostles and disciples and taught them the things that we have passed on for your consideration.

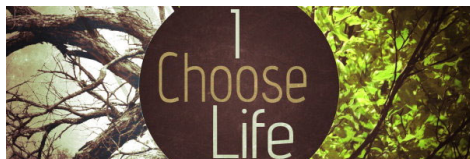

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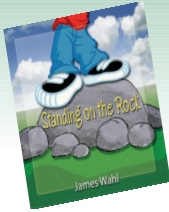
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St. Anselm (1033-1109)

April 21

Indifferent toward religion as a young man, Anselm became one of the Church's greatest theologians and leaders. He received the title "Father of Scholasticism" for his attempt to analyze and illumine the truths of faith through the aid of reason.

After careless disinterest in religion and years of worldly living, he finally fulfilled his desire to be a monk. He entered the monastery of Bec in Normandy, was elected prior three years later, and fifteen years later, was unanimously chosen abbot.

Considered an original and independent thinker, Anselm was admired for his patience, gentleness, and teaching skill. Under his leadership, the Abbey of Bec became a monastic school, influential in philosophical and theological studies.

Against his will, Anselm was appointed archbishop of Canterbury in 1093, at age 60.

His care and concern extended to the very poorest people. Opposing the slave trade, Anselm obtained from the national council at Westminster the passage of a resolution prohibiting the sale of human beings.
