Octave of Pentecost

According to ancient tradition, the Solemnity of Pentecost was extended by the celebration of an octave—eight days of prayer focused on the Holy Spirit.

Even though the octave is no longer officially observed in the liturgy, the spirit of that tradition may be preserved.

On the days after Pentecost (June 6-11), the 9:00 a.m. Mass will be celebrated with the outward solemnity of a Sunday, including organ accompaniment of hymns and chants, and the Mass of the day will be the Votive Mass of the Holy Spirit.

Month of the Sacred Heart

The Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus is an expression of the Christian conviction that Jesus—true God and true man—loves the human race with an infinite love that is at once both divine and human.

Sixteenth century Calvinism and seventeenth century Jansenism preached a distorted Christianity that substituted for God's love and sacrifice of His Son for all people, the fearful idea that a whole section of humanity was inexorably damned.

The Church always countered this view with the infinite love of our Savior who died on the cross for all people. The institution of the feast of the Sacred Heart was soon to contribute to the creation among the faithful of a powerful current of devotion which since then has grown stronger.

Pope Benedict XVI spoke of the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, saying, "In biblical language, 'heart' indicates the center of the person where his sentiments and intentions dwell. In the Heart of the Redeemer we adore God's love for humanity, his will for universal salvation, his infinite mercy. Practicing devotion to the Sacred Heart of Christ therefore means adoring that Heart which, after having loved us to the end, was pierced by a spear and from high on the Cross poured out blood and water, an inexhaustible source of new life" (Benedict XVI, Angelus: June 5, 2005).

The call which comes from this important feast day is first of all a call to Eucharistic adoration, because in the Sacred Host the Lord Jesus is truly present and He offers each of us His Heart, His Merciful Love. To spend time in the Presence of the Eucharistic Lord, to adore Him, is the best expression of devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

All new employees and volunteers will complete the Safe Haven—CMG Connect—online training program instead of VIRTUS training. The turnaround time for approval may be approximately two weeks or less.

The training consists of three vignette style training videos that is approximately 60 minutes and will include a criminal background check that must be completed. These trainings are available in English and Spanish, all are on-line.

All individuals must complete the training and complete a background check prior to the start of employment and/or volunteer service. Training is valid for five years, after which it will need to be updated by participating in a renewal program on-line.

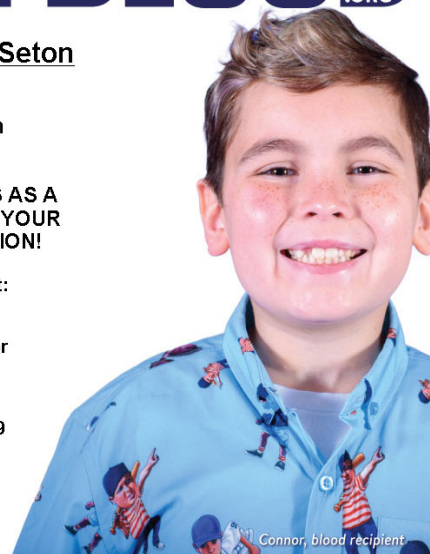

Deacon Daniel Nevares, S.J. will be ordained to the priesthood of Jesus Christ on Saturday, June 11 at St. Aloysius parish in Spokane Washington. Deacon Nevares is the son of George and Dolores Nevares of our parish.

Fr. Nevares will celebrate a Mass of Thanksgiving here at St. Elizabeth Ann Seton on Sunday, **July 17** at 8:30 a.m. Afterwards, there will be a reception, and you are most welcome to attend.



Daniel is a graduate of Strake Jesuit College Preparatory in Houston and received a bachelor's degree in psychology from Texas A&M. While teaching fifth graders in Greater Phoenix, he earned a master's in education from Arizona State University in Tucson.

Daniel has been to Nepal, Turkey, Chile and China, the latter being when he was an Aggie teaching at Shanghai Children's Discovery Museum. He attended St. Louis University in Missouri for First Studies and performed his Regency as a teacher of history at Gonzaga Preparatory School in Spokane, Washington.

Currently he is studying Theology at Jesuit School of Theology of Santa Clara University in Berkeley, California.

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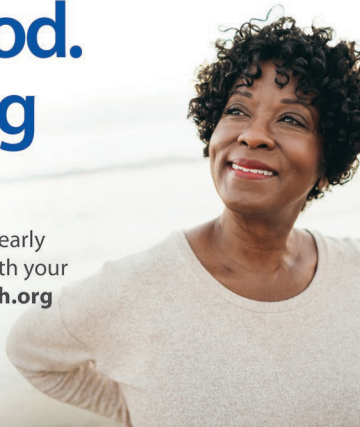
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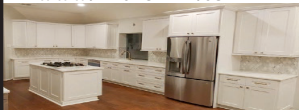
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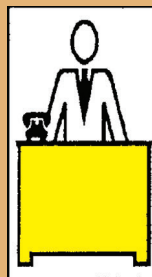
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
