THIS WEEK AT ST. ANN'S

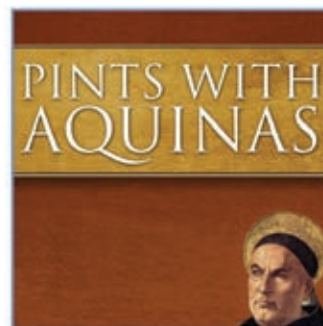
