## From the Pastor's Desk...



**SOLSTICE & STILLNESS** – I remember a scene from the TV show *Northern Exposure* (1990-1995). The episode revolves around a small town in Alaska preparing for a dance contest. At the start of the episode an Inuit woman named Marilyn was practicing with one man; however as the show concluded Marilyn was practicing with another man. Asked why she had changed from her first partner she replied, “He moved o.k. It was his stillness that was not good”. This Wednesday at 4:48 PM will be the winter solstice when the earth which has been travelling toward the sun (sol) for a moment is still (stice) and begins to head away from the sun. This stillness in nature can occasion a stillness in our souls and in our society.

Appearances can be deceiving. Even when I feel still, I am far from motionless. Earth is spinning on its axis at 1,000 mph; our planet is orbiting the Sun at 66,000 mph and our 100 light-year-wide Galaxy is moving away from the center of the universe at 550,000 mph! Add to this cosmic blur the swirl of desires around us and within us, and the cry of Wisdom 4:12 becomes ours: “For the witchery of paltry things obscures what is right and the whirl of desire transforms the innocent mind.”



T.S. Eliot wrote: "At the still point of the turning world....there the dance is." We proclaim in song (*Gather Hymnal #796*) that Christ is the Dance. It is with Christ that our souls can find rest,

ultimate meaning, purpose and stillness. It is not for nothing that the title of world's most beloved Christmas Carol is *Stille Nacht*, that is, Still Night or Night of Stillness.



My first year in the Seminary, a priest I admired said that the big obstacle to belief was the Incarnation: the in-the-flesh-ness of God. The Creator who by definition is apart from (distinct) from creation, entering into and becoming a part of creation??? As the years have gone by, I have come to see that the big hurdle is not so much *how* God could become one of us as it is *why* God would even begin to care about us. I don't care about ants and the difference between God is me is infinitely more than the difference between me and ants. 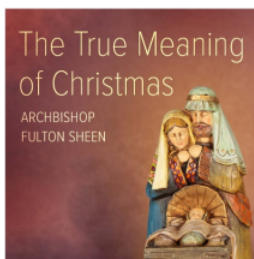
### **Christmas in Rome: A Celebration of the Nativity**
