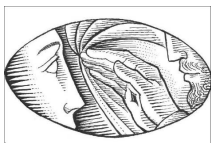

Sacramental Encounter – For those living sacramentally a big part of ongoing conversion of life is encountering Jesus in the Sacrament of Penance. This Lent we are offering three scheduled opportunities for Confessions in Chapel each week: 1) Tuesdays at 8:30 AM; 2) Wednesdays from 6:00 to 7:00 PM; 3) and Saturdays from 3:15 to 4:00 PM.

SOME HELPS – I invite you to join me in making use of the materials for adult examination of conscience that are available through our parish social media sites. Here are some soul-checks I find helpful:

1. “Save me, O God, from my unknown sin.” (Psalm 19:13)
2. When I pray the “Our Father” is there anyone or any group I am not including? Also after I myself have sinned, am leaving myself out?
3. If I spot it, I probably got it. It takes one to know one. (Luke 6:41-42).
4. What do I get out of not forgiving? What does not accepting forgiveness give me?
5. Can I accept the gift of heaven if I have bitterness in my heart? Will I be willing to accept the invitation to live with God without end if I harbor bitterness toward God or if resentment still haunts me? (Matthew 6:12-15; 18:21-22, 35; Mark 11:26; Luke 23:34)
6. So I went to confession and said, “Bless me, Father, for I have sinned. What’s bothering me is.....”. After having confessed my sins, the priest asked: “It’s good that you name what is bothering you. Have you asked Jesus what might be bothering Him? Have I asked the Lord if there is anything about my own actions, omissions or attitudes that bothers others?”
7. It is good to read the Bible. It is even better to let the Bible read me...
